High Performance Squad

Criteria

Dear Junior Rider,

For Squad inclusion during the 2010 season, The Performance Management team will be guided by certain criteria set out below. The adherence to these criteria will be expected from all combinations that wish to be included. The criteria that will be the deciding factors in the make up of the Junior Championship Squad are as follows:

- **Soundness & Suitability of Horse and Rider**
- **Adherence to Code of Conduct / Practices etc.**
- **Secure ownership of Horse**
- **Results based on the following:**

Compete in at least 2 Junior 'A' competitions during the Spring / Summer season as successfully as possible with a view to partaking in the CIC* at Ballindenisk on the 24th & 25th April 2010.

It is recommended that these classes be successfully completed with a completion score of not more than 55 Penalties in order to be considered for inclusion in the Junior Team to be announced later in the summer.

As well as having gained an FEI Qualification, which must be achieved by both horse and Rider as a combination within the previous 2 years, there will also be a requirement, for selection criteria purposes, to complete successfully in at least 1 (one) of the International competitions listed below with a completion score of not more than **60 Penalties**.

- **Barroca d'Alva (POR) CCI***
- **Verdalle – Touscayrats (FRA) CCI***
- **Jardy (FRA) CCI***
- **Houghton Hall (GBR) CCI***
- **Tattersalls (IRE) CCI***
- **Burgie (GBR) CCI***

A total of at least three (3) completion scores in the relative categories i.e. (CNC/CIC/CCI) is the minimum required for consideration for final selection.

The PM & Coaches are entitled to use their discretion in consultation with the HPM, to change the above criteria due to extreme circumstances such as, ground conditions, weather, etc.

It is the intention to announce a Team Squad after Burgie CCI is concluded.

A final 'preparatory run' will take place during Aug at a venue TBD prior to the Team travelling to the Championships in Sept.
