

Irish Sport Horse Showjumping Series 2010

Venues/Dates:

- Barnadown Show - 8 - 9th May
- Cavan Show - 15th - 16th May
- Ravensdale Lodge - 28th - 29th May
- Mullingar International CSI2* - 5th - 6th June
- Ballinamona Show - 12th - 13th June
- Galway County Show - 19th - 20th June
- Tattersalls International CSI2* - 24th - 25th July

Eligibility:

- Horses with the breed codes ISH, RID or ID that are registered in the Irish Horse Register, by a stallion APPROVED in the Main Section of the IHR, and with sire and dam documented on their passport are eligible to compete.
- Any stallion which has commenced the HSI Stallion Inspection procedure and has been awarded 'Preliminary Recommendation for Breeding' (PB) status is eligible to compete.

Series:

- Classes for 5 year olds and 6/7 year olds will be held at 7 venues throughout Ireland with the Grand Final taking place at the 7th venue Tattersalls International CSI2*. Horse/rider combinations who gain points throughout the Series will be invited to attend the Grand Final.
- All legs of the Series will run on a PRE-ENTRY basis.

5 Year Olds:

- At each of the 6 legs leading to the Grand Final, there will be a qualifier class leading to a final (to be held on the second day of the show).
- The qualifier class will run as a two phase class, i.e. two separate phases NOT against the clock (Article 274/5.1). The top 20 horses OR all double clears will qualify for the final.
- The final class will be run as a Two Round class with one-jump off (Article 238/1.1), with the second round being built at 5cm higher than the first round. The second round will be run as a jump-off but NOT against the clock. Horses must be clear in the first round to jump in the second round. The winner will be determined by faults. Where there are horses on equal faults, the win will be divided.
- Course builders will be asked to set the courses at 350 m/min.
- Up to and including Mullingar, the suggested heights will be 1m10 (S) for the qualifier classes and 1m15 (S) for the final classes. For the next 3 legs, the suggested heights will be 1m15 (S) for the qualifier classes and 1m20 for the final classes.
- Only non-performance enhancing hind boots as supplied by SJI can be worn in these classes. If riders do not wish to use the boots supplied by SJI or the nominated boots are not available for any reason then no boots or bandages of any kind will be permitted.
- Martingales are allowed but must be correctly fitted.

6/7 Year Olds:

- At each of the 6 legs leading to the Grand Final, there will be a qualifier class leading to a final (to be held on the second day of the show).
- The qualifier classes will be run as a two phase class with the second phase against the clock (Article 274/5.3). The top 20 horses will qualify for the final.
- The final class will be run as a jump-off class (Article 238/2.2, Table A with one jump-off).
- Course builders will be asked to set the courses at 350 m/min.
- The 7 year olds will be handicapped in all classes. The height bands of 1m25 (6 year old qualifier classes), 1m30 (7 year old qualifier classes), 1m30 (6 year old finals) and 1m35 (7 year old finals) will apply.
- Martingales are allowed but must be correctly fitted.
- Only non-performance enhancing hind boots as supplied by SJI can be worn in these classes. If riders do not wish to use the boots supplied by SJI or the nominated boots are not available for any reason, then no boots or bandages of any kind will be permitted.

Prize money:

- At each of the 6 legs there will be €10,000 in prize money on offer. There will be €500 on offer for each of the qualifying classes and €4,500 on offer for each of the final classes.
- Prize money in all cases will be awarded down to sixth place. In the case of equal placings in the 5 Year Old classes, prize money will be divided.
- At the Grand Finals there will be a total of €15,500 on offer. There will be €5,000 for each of the Grand Final classes, €1,750 on offer for each of the Leagues (riders' prizes) and €2,000 in breeders' prizes.
- Prize money breakdown:
 - Qualifier prize money: 1st €165, 2nd €110, 3rd €75, 4th €60, 5th €50, 6th €40
 - Final prize money: 1st €1,485, 2nd €990, 3rd €675, 4th €540, 5th €450, 6th €360
 - Grand Final prize money: 1st €1,650, 2nd €1,100, 3rd €750, 4th €600, 5th €500, 6th €400
 - League prize money (riders' prizes): 1st €1,000, 2nd €500, 3rd €250
 - Breeders' prizes: €1,000 per Grand Final
- Prize money will be paid by cheque to the owner of the horse, as registered with Showjumping Ireland, unless otherwise requested with HSI.

Points/League System:

- The Series will be run as a League. Horse/rider combinations that have gained points throughout the Series will be invited to attend the Grand Final. Points will be award in the final classes only (not in the qualifier classes).
- Points will also be awarded at the Grand Final, with the top three horse/rider combinations winning the League prizes.
- League points for 5 year olds: Double Clear – 5 points, Single Clear – 2 points.
- League points for 6/7 year olds: 1st 10, 2nd 8, 3rd 6, 4th 4, 5th 3, 6th 2, 7th 1, 8th 1, 9th 1, 10th 1.
- The League will strictly be run on a horse/rider combination basis.

Grand Final:

- Both the 5 year old and 6/7 year old classes will be run as jump-off classes.
- The 5 Year Old Grand Final will run at 1m20.
- In the 6/7 Year Old Grand Final, the 6 year olds will jump at 1m30 and the 7 year olds at 1m35.

FEI World Breeding Championships for Young Horses, Lanaken 2010:

- The Irish Sport Horse Studbook Showjumping Series will be used as part of the selection process for horses selected to participate at Lanaken 2010.

Notes:

- No Temporary Tickets are allowed in these classes.
- In the case of eligibility in terms of age and breeding, 'Hors Concours' entries will NOT be allowed.
- In the case of eligibility in terms of the hind boot rules, any rider in breach of the rule will be considered as jumping 'Hors Concours'.
