

## **CRITERIA FOR FEI BADGES OF HONOUR**

### **SHOW JUMPING**

1. FEI Badges of Honour for Jumping will be awarded to those athletes who have completed the first round of a Nations Cup, the Team and/or Individual Competition at the Olympic Games and the World and Senior Continental Team and/or Individual Championships, without retiring or being eliminated on the following scale:

A Gold Badge for completing 40 Nations Cup competitions.

A Silver Badge for completing 20 Nations Cup competitions.

A Bronze Badge for completing 10 Nations Cup competitions.

2. All count as 5 Nations Cup competitions:

the Team and/or Individual Competition at the Olympic Games

the Team and/or Individual World Championship.

the Team and/or Individual Continental Championship.

### **EVENTING**

Badges of Honour will be awarded to Athletes who complete the competition at Championships/CCI(O)s Four Star Level (4\*), according to the following scale:

A Gold Badge for completing six Championships/CCIOs

A Silver Badge for completing four Championships/CCIOs

A Bronze Badge for completing two Championships/CCIOs.

Eventing at the Olympic Games or at the World Championships is equivalent to two CCIOs

### **DRESSAGE**

4. Badges of Honour will be awarded on the following scale to athletes:

4.1. who have been among the 15 best in the Grand Prix at a CDIO

In 14 CDIO - Gold Badge

In 10 CDIO - Silver Badge

In 6 CDIO - Bronze Badge

4.2. Participation in the Grand Prix Special (Championship Formula) at a CDIO is equal to two CDIOs;

4.3. Participation in the Grand Prix Special or Grand Prix Freestyle (Nations Cup Formula) at a CDIO is equal to two CDIOs;

4.4. Participation in the Grand Prix Special at Continental Championships, World Championships and the Olympic Games is equal to three CDIOs;

4.5. Participation in the Grand Prix Freestyle (Championship Formula) at a CDIO is equal to three CDIOs;

4.6. Participation in the Grand Prix Freestyle at Continental Championships, World Championships, the FEI World Cup™ Dressage Final and the Olympic Games, is equal to four CDIOs;

5. Applications for badges must be accompanied by supporting evidence.
