FEI World Breeding Eventing Championships for Young Horses Le Lion d'Angers (FRA) 20-23 October 2011

I. Participation / Invitations

Athletes are invited by the Organising Committee through their NF (Art. 121.1 will apply).

A **total of 110 horses** will be allowed to participate: 40 six-year old horses in the CCI1* / 70 seven-year old horses in the CCI2*.

Maximum number of horses per NF and host Nation:	3 for the CCI* & 12 for the CCI2*
Number of horses of the inviting nation:	3 for the CCI* & 12 for the CCI2*

Case of excessive entries:

In case of excessive entries (more than 110 horses), a ballot system based on FEI Eventing Horse ranking (established for the purpose of this championship only) will apply, and in the limit of the quota of horse per nation, to be determined on the date of the nominative entries.

Any specific cases will be reviewed by a ad-hoc committee composed of the OC, WBFSH and the FEI.

II. Minimum Eligibility Requirements as per Art. 505.5 & 506.7

All qualifying events must be achieved as a combination.

The deadline for obtaining the minimum eligibility requirements is 4 weeks before the 1st Dressage day of the Championship (20 September 2011) and must be obtained in the calendar year in question or the preceding calendar year.

	Minimum qualifying events to achieve
Young Horse Championship 6 years old	1 CIC1* with zero obstacle penalties on XC and max 4 penalties on obstacles (max one rail down) in the Jumping test + 1 CNC1*
Young Horse Championship 7 years old	1 CCI1* or 1CIC 2* with zero obstacle penalties on XC <u>plus</u> 1 CIC2* or 2 CNC 2* with zero obstacle penalties on XC and max 4 penalties on obstacles (max 1 rail down) in the Jumping test

III. ENTRIES

Competitors are entered by the Organising Committee through their NF (Art. 121.1)

↳ Nominated Entries:	19 September 2011
↳ Definite Entries:	14 October 2011

IV. WBFSH STUDBOOK

Medals will be provided by the WBFSH.

A ranking will be established between the studbooks members of the WBFSH.

The winning studbook member is the one with the lowest total of penalty points, after adding together the final score of the 3 highest placed competitors (6 year-old penalties have a coefficient of 1,25 and 7 year-old penalties have a coefficient of 1).

All horses entering the FEI World Breeding Eventing Championships for Young Horses are automatically entered to participate in the World Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing. The entry form must be completed entirely. All information concerning the studbook must be communicated.

The native studbook member will check the information given on the entry **form** to take part in the World Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing.

The entry form must be filled in entirely. It corresponds to the standard norms of the FEI entry, as well as the information requested by the OC for the participation in the World Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing.

The entry form must be filled in online (www.mondialdulion.com, on Internet) to register the nominated entries of the athlete and horse for the participation in the FEI World Breeding Eventing Championships for Young Horses of 6 years old and 7 years old.

The OC gives the information to the studbook for validation.

The studbook must send the entry back to the OC before the first Horse Inspection, to be entitled to take part in the World Breeding Trophy for Young Horses - Eventing.
