HEAD INJURY or CONCUSSION ------ WARNING

For at least the next 24 hours,

DO NOT

Do Not Ride a Horse or operate heavy machinery Do Not Drive a Motor car, Do Not Ride a Motor bike or bicycle, Avoid excess visual stimulation Do NOT use a computer or electronic devices <u>Do Not drink Alcohol</u>

<u>D0</u>

Get plenty of rest Take prescribed medications or Paracetamol for Pain

RETURN to the Accident & Emergency Department IF YOU Have Severe HEADACHES Are CONFUSED or Have Difficulty Concentrating Start VOMITING Have Blurred or Double VISION Have excessive DROWSINESS or Have a FIT or CONVULSION

<u>After a Head Injury</u>, it is common to have mild headaches, difficulty with concentration, irritability or dizzy turns. If the above should persist more than a few days, you should visit your own Doctor or return to the Accident & Emergency Department.
