Competition B- MARATHON

Two Section Section A – Approx. 7Km on public roads Section B – Approx. 8Km on grass

There will be 8 obstacles including water and a high rise bank

Crystal Combination will drive 6 obstacles. Gates A-D only. Gates E & F are neutral Pre-novice will drive the full marathon and Gates A-D only. Gates E & F are neutral

Competition C – CONES

Scheduling of Cones competition will be decided based on entries

The cones competition will be a fault competition. The course will be between 500m and 800m with a maximum of 20 obstacles which may include a box. There will be no drive off. Extending Axles, (where required), to be used in all classes except Classes 1 & 2.

Entry Condition	Entry Conditions: All Irish drivers should have completed two events in the last two seasons to qualify for the championships. The committee reserve the right to invite individuals to compete in the championship. Proof of insurance will be required from non CDI/HSI members.					
Age of driver:	All competitors must be 10 or over (see CDI/HSI rules for groom qualifications)					
Equines:	Equines must be registered with CDI/HSI or NICDA Equines must be at least 4 years old. Vaccinations must be annual and up to date.					
Entry Fee:	All Classes €80 Withdrawals: Entry Fees less €15 will be refunded for the withdrawals on or before Monday 25 th August, withdrawals after 25 th August will not be refunded.

Entries will only be accepted on the attached National Championship Entry Form. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted.
