TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1

Depart Dublin to fly to Brussels. Board your coach to travel to Lanaken, home of the FEI World Breeding Jumping Championships for Young Horses. This closing event of the breeding season has become an established venue in the international showjumping world!

Check into Sandton Hotel in Eindhoven. Evening meal at hotel.

Day 2

Breakfast at your hotel. Full day at Lanaken. Transfer back to your hotel for your evening meal.

Day 3

Breakfast at your hotel. Morning stud farm visit to Duyselhof Stud, one of Holland's leading stud farms carrying the VDL Groep suffix and home base of riders Leopold van Asten and Eric & Maikel van der Vleuten. The farm breeds, rears and trains top show jumpers.

Transfer to Bocholt to visit Ashford Farm, home of Irish man Enda Carroll. The afternoon will be spent at Stal Hendrix, the internationally-renowned jumping and trading yard of Paul & Emilie Hendrix. Transfer back to your hotel for your evening meal.

Day 4

Breakfast at your hotel. A morning stud farm visit to KWPN Centre Ermelo where mare performance testing will be underway. This is followed by an afternoon stud farm visit at Team Nijhof, stud farm and sport stable of international repute. Transfer back to your hotel for your evening meal.

Day 5

Breakfast at your hotel and check out. A morning stud farm visit to Tilleman-Lenaerts' farm in Belgium - home of the stallion Touloun & others - the enterprise of Luc & Kaat Tilleman-Lenaerts.

Euro Horse Farm, base of riders Harrie Smolders & Jos Verlooy and home to stallion Emerald amongst others, will also be visited.

Transfer to Brussels Airport for your flight home.
