- Entry fees for the qualifying class should not exceed €25 and for the finals should not exceed €45;

- A Senior National Judge and National Judge must form part of the Ground Jury for all classes held as part of the Championship;
- A Starter and Stipendiary Steward must be in place for the Championship;
- Shows be must affiliated to Showjumping Ireland.

- International show;
- National Grand Prix show;
- Autumn Grand Prix show;
- Avoidance of clashes with other shows;
