### Conditions:

The following conditions must be met in order for your venue to be considered to run the ISH Studbook Young Horse Eventing Series

### Classes

The venue must be able to hold the following classes:

AGE	DRESSAGE	SHOW JUMPING	XC
4 Year Old	TBC	0.90m	0.90m
5 Year Old	TBC	1.00m	1.00m
5 & 6 Year Old Ponies	TBC	1.00m	1.00m
6 Year Old	TBC	1.15m	1.10m

- The venue must commit not to run any other age classes during the event
- The venue must be affiliated to Eventing Ireland
- The horses competing will all have qualified at national events during the year
- Entry Fees will be as per Eventing Ireland

### Sponsorship

There are to be no other sponsors for these classes. These classes will be known exclusively as the ISH Studbook Young Horse Eventing Class.

### Prize/Bonus Money

- Eventing Ireland Prize money will be paid as per the Eventing Ireland Rule 7.2.
- Bonus prize money will be awarded by Horse Sport Ireland
- Prize winners will be required to attend the official prize giving at the event

### Criteria:

In order to select the venue for the ISH Studbook Young Horse Eventing Series, the following criteria must be outlined:

#### Suitability of Venue

- Courses – courses up-to-standard and well maintained
- Arena Surfaces – confirm what surfaces will be used for dressage and show jumping
- Catering Facilities – confirm whether catering is onsite or mobile catering will be used
- Other Facilities – Toilet facilities (onsite/portable), facilities for horses (water, washing etc)

- Consideration will be given to dates later in the calendar, ie: in September or October
