National Equine Anti-Doping Programme Summary 2013

The period under review in this report is 1st January 2013 – 31st December 2013. During this time the Irish Equestrian Federation Equine Anti-Doping Programme carried out 114 tests.

Table 1: Doping/Controlled Medication Rule Violations – summary of categories of substance (closed cases, reported in the review time frame)

The following table details the categories of substance for all closed cases to be publicly reported on. Possible anti-doping rule violations are grouped according to the categories outlined in the FEI prohibited list.
