

HSI Three and Four-Year-Old Loose-Jumping Filly Competitions

Criteria and Scoring System

These competitions are for three and four-year-old fillies and aim to identify young performance fillies that may be suitable for the breeding herd. By entering you provide consent to have your filly linear profiled for research under National Breeding Services at these events. Filly loose jumping is funded by the Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine under National Breeding Services and delivered by Horse Sport Ireland.

There will be three qualifiers for horses with separate categories for 3yo and 4yo fillies. There will be a separate, stand-alone competition for 3yo and 4yo filly ponies. The qualifiers will be held in September & October. The **top three** highest scoring fillies from the <u>HORSE</u> 3yo and 4yo categories will be selected for the final at each qualifier.

Loose Jumping Championship Final 2nd October
Emerald Equestrian Centre

The final will be held at Emerald EC on the 2nd October where Champions will be named in the 3yo and 4yo categories. A prize fund of €7,500 including breeder prizes will be on offer at the final for qualified entries.

- Entries must be made online and payment made directly to the venue. Payments are processed by the venue(s) separately to applications.
- There will be no entries on the day allowed for the HORSE competition. However, entries
 on the day for the PONY competition will be allowed. Late entries will not be included in the
 published start list.
- A start list and start time will be allocated to each competitor by email. Competitors must be present for their allotted time to compete.
- The filly horse competitions are open to any three or four-year-old horse that is studbook registered with a breed recorded (this can include main or supplementary section studbook animals)
 - The top ranked Traditional Irish Horse (TIH) filly will be awarded a prize in the 3- & 4-year-old horse loose jumping sections.
 - The top three highest scoring fillies from the **HORSE** 3- & 4-year-old horse loose jumping sections will be selected for the final at each qualifier.





- Passports <u>must</u> be available for inspection by HSI staff and judges at the competitions. Prize money will not be paid to fillies that do not meet the studbook registration requirements.
- Breeder's prizes will only be paid to breeders residing on the Island of Ireland.

- Equine Anti-Doping: The Horse Sport Ireland (HSI) Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication (EADCM) Rules apply, and entrants are subject to a Blood and/or Urine sample being taken for analysis. - Horse Sport Ireland reserve the right to change or alter the terms and conditions of the Loose
 Jumping Filly 3yo and 4yo Championship at any time.

Criteria for entry

- The filly horse competitions are open to any three or four-year-old horse that is studbook registered with a breed recorded (this can include main or supplementary section studbook animals)
- The filly pony competition is open to any three and four-year-old pony that is studbook registered with a breed recorded (main or supplementary section).
- The loose jumping pony competition will have a height restriction based on the measurement of the height at the withers which cannot exceed a maximum of 151.0cm with shoes on the day of competition.
- Pony height will be measured by a veterinarian on the day. The HSI appointed veterinarian's decision on the day is final.
- 3- & 4-year-old horse fillies can enter up to a maximum of 2 qualifiers, where they have not won prize money at any previous qualifier.
- The filly's passport must be available on the day for inspection.
- Fillies should present to the vet at least 15 minutes prior to their allotted start time for the qualifier.
- Fillies must be led to and from the arena and only turned loose when requested to do so by the judges.
- Where a qualified filly is unable to attend the final, the next highest scoring reserve from **any qualifier** will be offered the place in the final.
- Should there be a tie, the filly with the highest SCOPE score will progress.
- Should there a be a tie in scope the combined scope and technique score will be awarded the space.
- The judges' decision on the day is final.

Welfare

- It is important for your filly to be well prepared for the classes in the interest of safety. It is advised that the filly has been handled and familiarised with loose jumping/loose movement.
- Any evidence of fillies having been over or unnaturally produced which could be detrimental for their future development and general well-being may mean elimination from the competition.
- Please do not attend if your filly is unwell or unsound.
- Vets will assess each horse/ pony and assign a <u>Body Condition Score (BCS)</u>. Should the vet deem the BCS to be too low, this may mean exclusion from the competition.
- Equine welfare is paramount for all activities; equines should not have their whiskers trimmed or be inappropriately produced for or handled during any of the events.
- Judges and Arena Party reserves the right to end the jumping portion of the competition, where a filly is deemed too green or may be a danger to herself and others.





- Prize money will be paid out directly to the competitor, by HSI, after the event.
- Details for prize payment processing must be provided with the application to ensure efficient processing after each event.
- Prize money will only be paid out where the filly has an eligible studbook passport and is in correct ownership.
- Failure to adhere to the above terms and conditions may result in prize money being forfeited.
