Foreword

The Traditional Irish Horse (TIH) represents the foundation of Ireland's sport horse breeding heritage, preserving the influence of traditional Irish bloodlines that have long defined the athleticism, soundness, and temperament for which the Irish horse is renowned. This report provides a comprehensive analysis of the TIH population within the Irish Sport Horse Studbook. The findings provide valuable insights for breeders, policy makers, and industry stakeholders, supporting evidence-based decisions that for safeguarding the future of the TIH.

Through the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (DAFM)-funded National Breeding Services, there are several targeted supports to promote and recognise the TIH, including dedicated prize funds in certain schemes, breeding grant funding to support TIH-specific classes alongside access to all DAFM-funded breeding schemes, open to all studbook breeds.

In addition to these financial supports, HSI continues to strengthen non-monetary recognition of the TIH. These include the novel use of the shamrock symbol on ISH-TIH passports, ongoing engagement with the Traditional Irish Horse Association (TIHA), recognition of TIH breeders at the Dublin Horse Show, and the updating of TIH classifications within the FEI database where possible. Furthermore, genomic research into TIH breed composition, led by Dr, Jennifer Doyle, and the publication of this report demonstrate HSI's commitment to data-led monitoring of the TIH population.

The insights captured in this report reaffirm the importance of the TIH within Ireland's breeding landscape and highlight the continued dedication of Irish breeders to maintaining and promoting traditional Irish bloodlines. Horse Sport Ireland remains committed to supporting this work through collaboration, research, and targeted investment in sustainable breeding practices.

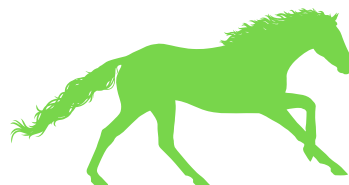

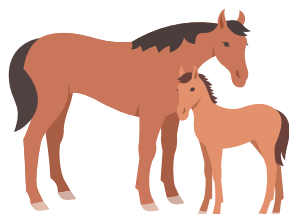

Introduction

Ireland, known fondly as the Land of the Horse, has a long history of successful horse breeding dating back over 2000 years with the Irish Hobby horse. The Irish Hobby was later combined with the Irish Draught, the Connemara pony, and the Thoroughbred to create the Irish Hunter; a breed that excelled at showjumping and eventing throughout the 20th century. In 1974, on establishment of the Irish Sport Horse (ISH) studbook, the Irish Hunter became known as the Irish Sport Horse.

In 1982, the first progeny of foreign stallions crossed with Irish mares were registered in the ISH studbook. Since then, there has been an increase in the importation of continental Warmblood breeds, and their germinal products, to Ireland and there is now a considerable amount of crossbreeding with these breeds in the ISH studbook, which has supported the studbooks' adaptation to the modern sporting disciplines. In 2011, the Traditional Irish Horse Association (TIHA) was formed to identify, conserve, and improve the Traditional Irish Horse which comprised the original ISH and Irish Hunter with no continental influence.

Thanks to the work of the TIHA, the TIH category was introduced to the ISH studbook in 2017 in order to differentiate between the traditionally bred ISH with only Irish breeds in the back pedigree and the ISH with a more continental influence. To be eligible for this category, under the current definition, a horse must:

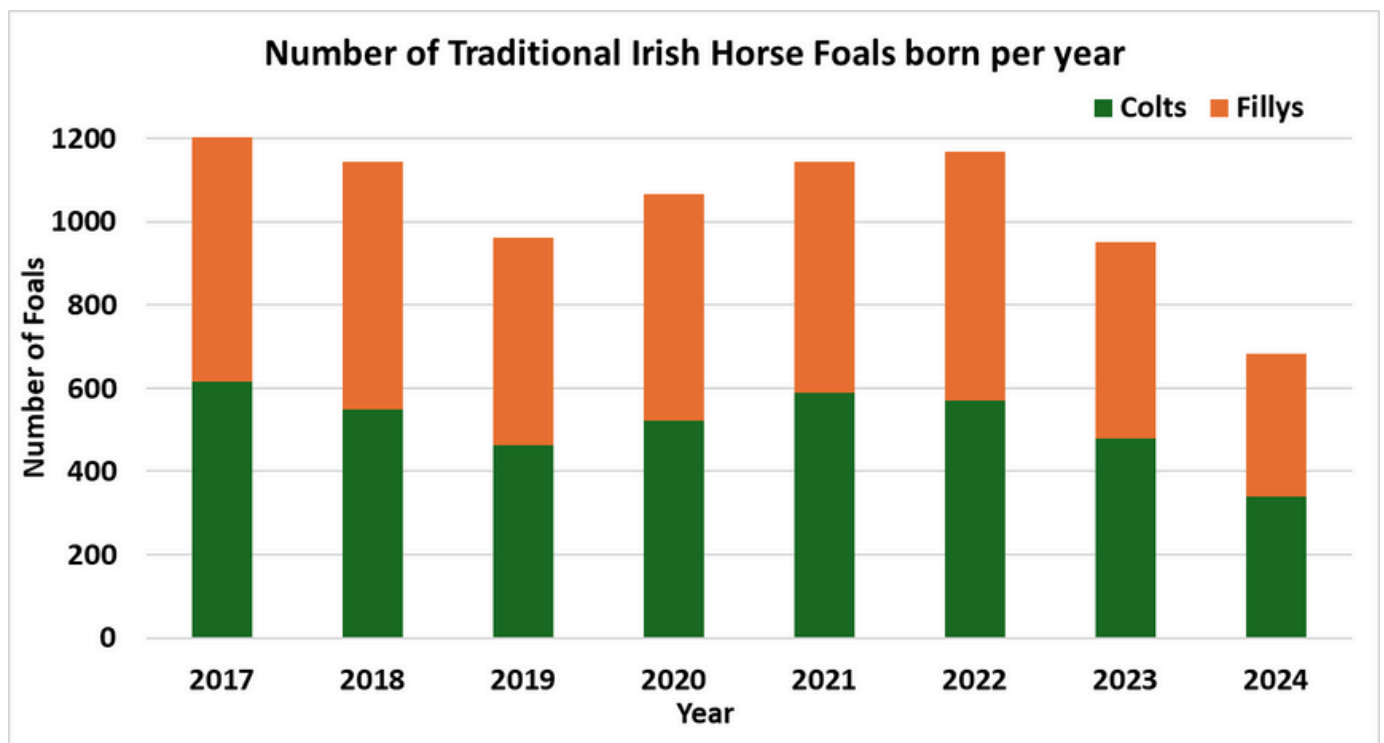
- Be registered in the Main Section of the Irish Sport Horse Studbook
- And*
- Have only the following breeds recorded in their pedigree: Irish Sport Horse, Irish Draught, Thoroughbred, Connemara Pony with no foreign ancestors recorded in their back pedigree
- And*
- Have no unknown ancestors in the first two generations
- And*
- All Irish Sport Horse ancestors from the second generation with unknown/partial pedigree must have been born before 1982.

This report was commissioned to assess the genetic diversity of TIH horses in Ireland and to map TIH trends over time. This report outlines the genetic diversity of the TIH, including overall population statistics, inbreeding trends, pedigree completeness, and Thoroughbred percentage. All TIH stallions that have produced at least one TIH foal since 2017 have been assessed for these attributes to enable breeders to implement this information in their future breeding decisions.



Population Statistics

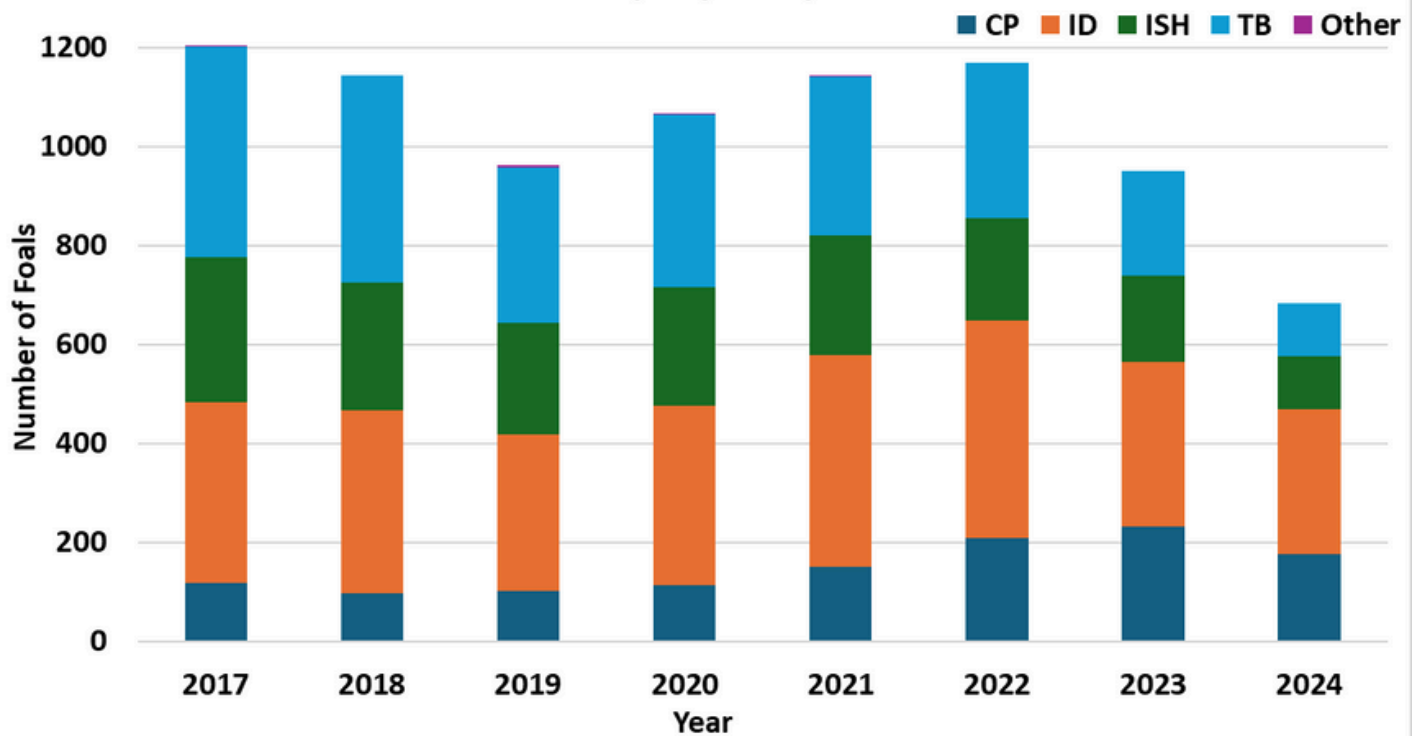
The TIH category has been designated on Irish Sport Horse passports since 2017 with the number of TIH foals peaking in that year with 1,204 TIH registrations. On average, there have been around 1,070 TIH foals registered per year since. The number of foals born in 2024 is currently just over 680 but may increase due to late registration of some horses. In general, the ratio of colt to filly foals has always been 50:50.



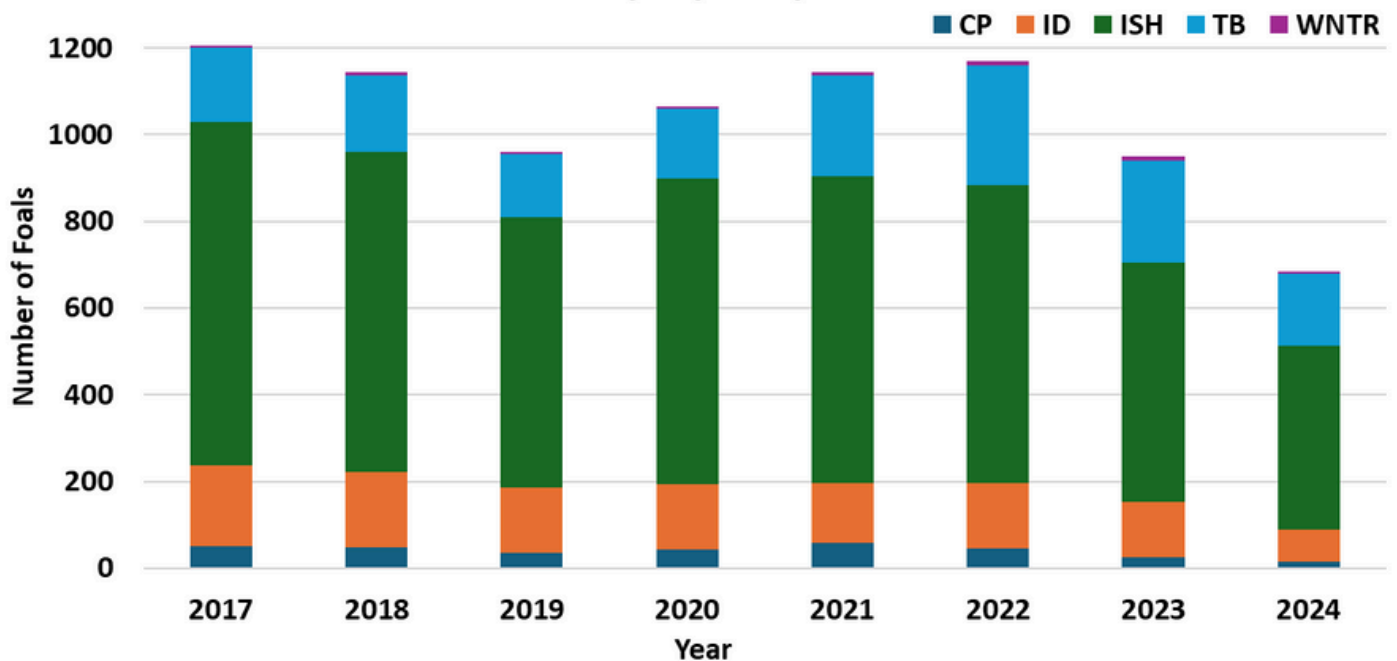
The TIH can be a cross of any of the following breeds: the Irish Sport Horse (ISH), Irish Draught (ID), Thoroughbred (TB), and Connemara Pony (CP), with no foreign breeding in the back pedigree. The number of TIH foals broken down by both sire and dam breed per year is in the figures on the next page. The most common sire breeds are unsurprisingly TB and ID, while the most common dam breed is the ISH.

Until 2024, the number of stallions producing a TIH foal per year remained consistently around 350, however, many of these stallions only produce one TIH progeny per year. The maximum number of TIH progeny a single stallion has had per year has ranged from 23 to 40 since the TIH designation has been implemented. In 2024, 93% of the 293 stallions that produced a TIH foal had 5 or less TIH progeny in that year.

Breeder Profile: Bridget McGing



Bridget started her successful TIH breeding program with a little mare, Sheeva (ISH)[TIH] by Macrocket (TB), that she bought in Co. Cork and that she competed herself in amateur level showjumping, eventing, showing, hunting - and everything in between! This mare is in the back pedigree of both Inquisitor (ISH)[TIH], who competed in the 2024 World Breeding Eventing Championships for young horses, and Master Point (ISH)[TIH], her 5* event horse. With one mare from this bloodline currently breeding, Bridget has several promising young horses that may prove to be ones to watch in the future!

Why do you like to breed TIH?

B: *"I think the TIH is a horse still very well suited to eventing as long as you're prepared to wait. They do take more time than the continental types. They need to be 5 - 7 year olds before they're sort of desirable. And I think that's one of the main reasons why people are slow to breed them as it's hard to sell them as three year olds because they're not as flashy jumping on the lunge, they tend to take longer to come into themselves. But then I think that they last longer, and I think that they tend to be, better horses... I love a blood horse. I love a Thoroughbred, really. But I think the ideal eventer is still something that is 60, 70, 80% thoroughbred. I think they have the stamina and soundness and, just a desire to do it, I suppose. I think the most important thing in the eventers is the will to do it, and trainability, I suppose. Trainability would be a big thing about TIH's, I think"*

Who is your foundation mare?

B: *"I suppose I like the mare, Chikari (ISH)[TIH], that I have at the moment, but she's retired now, she's 24 by Kings Master (ISH)[TIH] out of Sheeva and she's the dam of Master Point, he's the best horse we've bred. He was 13th in Badminton this year, and he's heading back to Burghley. He has now completed Badminton, Burghley, Luhmuhlen, and Pau, all the five stars in Europe. So I suppose she's nice. I suppose, the two sort of standout horse's for me in the last two years are Inquisitor (by Coroner (TB) out of Diamond Fleck(ISH)[TIH]) and Master Point (by Pointilliste (TB))."*

What is your target market for your TIHs?

B: *"I like to start them as 4 year olds, or even 3 year olds, but I think the chances of selling them at that age are small. I do young event horse classes, and that would be enough for the 4 and 5 year*

olds and they're going to be six or seven before their really saleable, usually. It's so expensive to produce an event horse so I try and pick the special ones that I hope might go to the top. I haven't sold any foals in years to be honest, I mean, I used to go to Goresbridge occasionally, and sometimes I might still go with a 3 year old"

What stallions have contributed to your breeding program?

B: *"Well, I suppose I'd have to say Pointilliste as he's the sire of my best horse. I like a TB sire but I think that we're running into problems in Ireland because a lot of nice sports horse mares have maybe 70 or 80% TB, and you can't really go back to a TB. But then there's only a few TIH sport horse sires available. Maybe we should be looking at identifying the ones that are 25/50% TIH so when you have a TIH mare with 70 or 80% TB, you don't want to go to a draught if you're trying to breed eventers or even jumpers, really, and you don't want to go to a TB because there's too much TB in her already. So what do you do, you're looking for sport horse, and there's nearly nothing out there that's competing as a TIH sport horse. I know there's Susan Malee's Carrabeg The Full Irish, I am interested to see how he gets on."*

What are your stallion plans for this year?

B: *"I suppose there's nothing really in eventing lines. There's a few show jumping like Susan Malee's horse, Carrabeg The full Irish."*

He's an interesting one, I think, but I'm just not sure if he's blood enough for eventing. But, let's see how he breeds I suppose. But what else is there? There isn't really a whole lot out there if you don't want to go to a Thoroughbred or a Draught. I think Sir Jim Jim (ISH)[TIH] is getting a few but in my opinion, he's more of a jumper type."

If you could have bred any TIH, what would you like to have bred, and why?

B: *"I'd have to go maybe Cruising. He's bred both eventers and showjumpers but they were difficult. I always liked the mare Robert Splaine used to ride, Heather Blaze. She's a grey mare that Robert Splaine rode around on Teams and things. I always thought she was a lovely mare."*



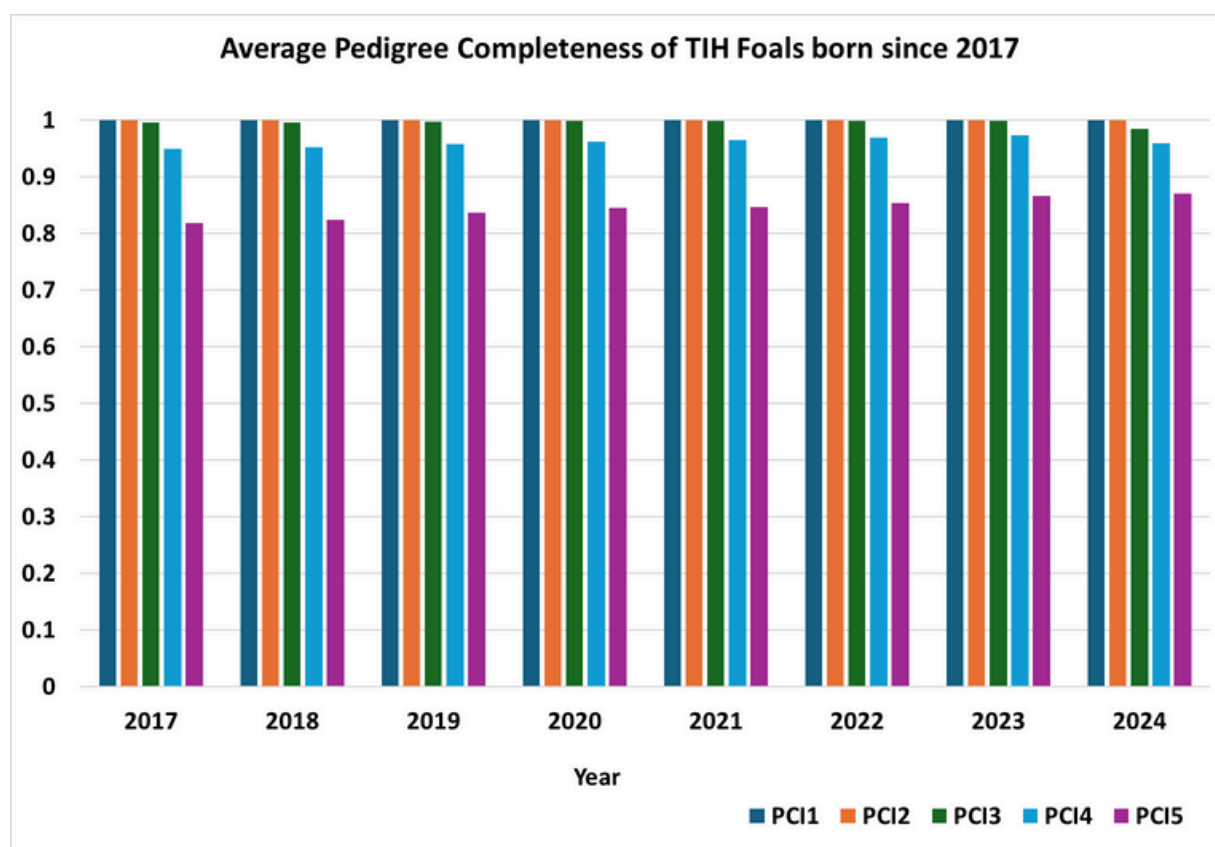

Pedigree Completeness

A pedigree completeness index (PCI) represents how many completed generations of ancestors are known per animal. Each generation is given a value between 0 and 1, where a PCI of 0 indicates that no ancestors in that generation are recorded and 1 indicated that all ancestors in that generation are known. For example, a PCI of 1 at Generation 3, where an animal has 8 ancestors (great-grandparents) means all 8 ancestors are recorded, a PCI of 0.875 at generation 3 means one ancestor is missing, and a PCI of 0.75 at generation 3 means two ancestors are missing, and so on. The PCI is important when assessing the quality of the pedigree information of an animal and is an important statistic to evaluate alongside the pedigree inbreeding and relatedness of an animal as it enables a more thorough evaluation of an animal's pedigree.

As one of the requirements of being designated a TIH is that all ancestors in the first two generations must be recorded, the PCI of both generation 1 and 2 in all TIH foals since 2017 is of course 1. Of the 950 TIH foals born in 2023, only 5 had a PCI at generation 3 less than 1, compared to 26 foals with a PCI at generation 3 less than 1 in 2017. In general, the PCI of all generations is increasing every year.



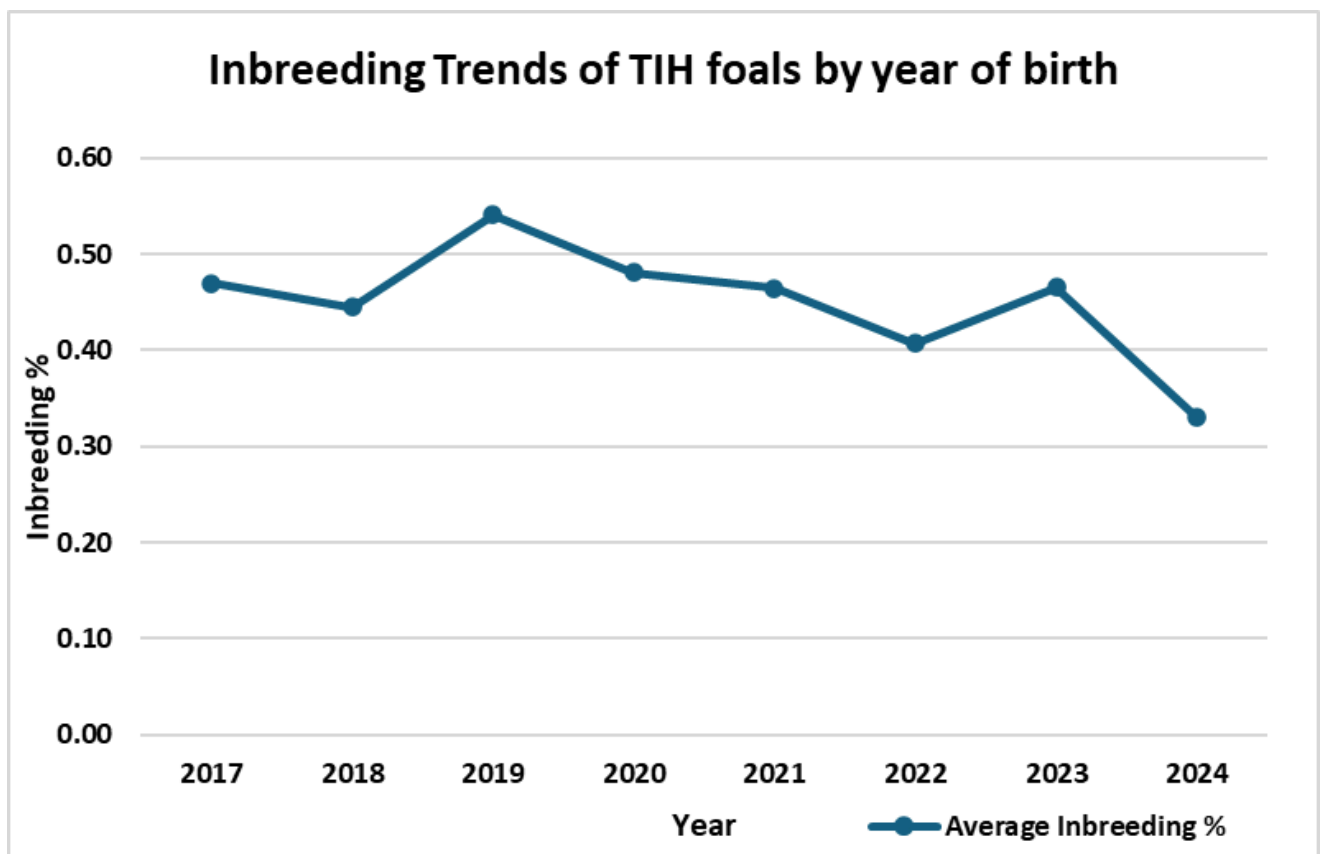


Inbreeding

Inbreeding, also known as linebreeding, is the production of an offspring from the breeding of closely related individuals. While inbreeding can make it easier to predict what traits will be passed on to the offspring, it also makes it more likely that the offspring will inherit negative characteristics including certain health defects and diseases. When inbreeding occurs, it speeds up the loss of genetic diversity within a population. However, a low level of inbreeding (<6.25%) is often seen as acceptable in livestock breeds.

The inbreeding coefficient is the measurement of the degree of inbreeding and is usually given as a percentage. Typical inbreeding percentages, assuming no previous inbreeding between any parents, are as follows:

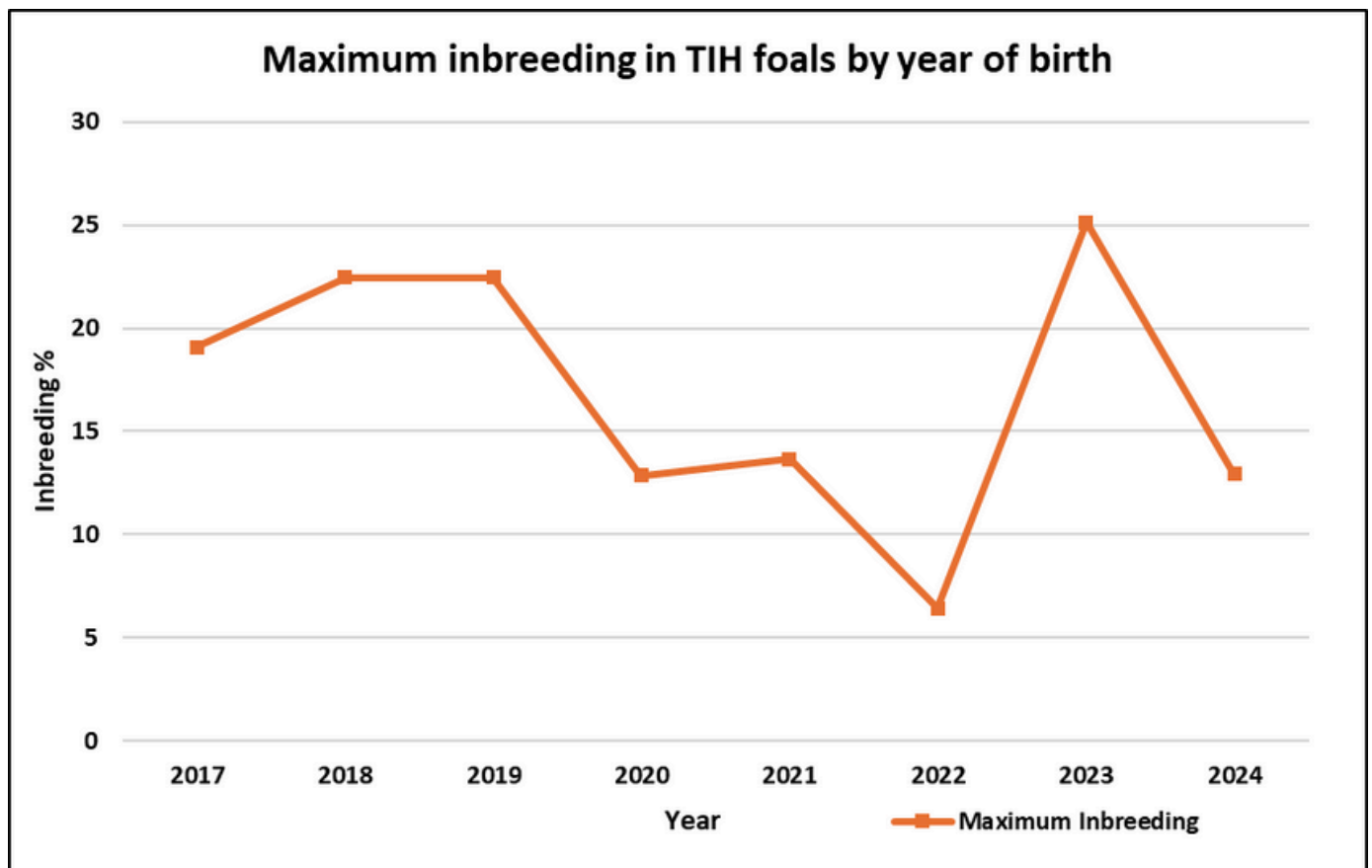
- Sire/daughter or Dam/son mating → 25%
- Full sibling mating → 25%
- Half sibling mating → 12.5%
- Grandsire/granddaughter or granddam/grandson mating → 12.5%
- Uncle/niece or aunt/nephew (aunt/uncle and parent are full siblings) → 12.5%
- Parents have a common grandsire/granddam (First Cousins) → 6.25%
- Parents have a common great-grandsire/great-granddam → 3.125%





Inbreeding

The TIH is a crossbred comprised of a number of different breeds, therefore, the average level of inbreeding observed within the TIH population remains lower than what would usually be observed in a closed studbook. The average inbreeding of the TIH foal crop within year is less than 0.5% - much less than the usual acceptable level of 6.25% in livestock animals. In fact, 99.97% of all TIH foals born since 2017 have had an inbreeding percentage less than 3.125% - the percentage that would be expected if parents have a common great-grandsire/great-granddam.



While the average levels of inbreeding are very low, it can still be observed that there are some animals with a higher than desired level of inbreeding. In 2023, the maximum inbreeding was 25.12% - the equivalent of the dam being bred back to her own sire to produce a foal.

Breeder Profile: Samantha Fitzsimons



Samantha, breeds under the Carrafarm prefix with her friend, Niamh Grimes. They currently have four active broodmares, three Irish Draughts and one Traditional Irish Sport Horse. They usually aim to have two to three foals per year as both are working full time outside the equine industry.

The ladies generally breed a mix of Irish Draught and Traditional Irish Sport Horse foals. They emphasise that it depends on the mare, and finding a stallion that suits the mare best is very important to them.

Who is your foundation mare?

S: “Our Irish Draught mare, *Pagestown Harmony*, by *Crosstown Dancer (ID)* bred by *Aidan Travers*. I suppose we'd call her our foundation mare. She has fantastic movement and Niamh rode her and she won the *Balmoral Performance* as a four-year-old and she got her dressage merit from *Horse Sport Ireland*, as a result of the points that she had with *Dressage Ireland*. So we have bred a couple of draught foals from her and she is really well suited to the blood cross too. So we've now bred three TIH out of her and the eldest one is four, who we still have. And then we have a yearling from last year and this year's foal, both by *Carrick Diamond Royale (ISH)[TIH]*, and she is back in foal to him for next year. The movement that the draught mare brings to that cross is exceptional. So we're delighted with those progeny of hers.”



What kind of markets do you sell in?

S: “I'm not really mad about selling foals. I think it's a big gamble that someone who buys a foal from you turns out to be the exact kind of horse that they're looking for. I would rather keep them until they're three. I think it gives you an opportunity to give them a really good start in life. We like to get showing a little bit, with their mothers when they're foals just to see a bit of the world when they're still on their dams and then try and get them out once or twice each year.

So if we can at all, we'd like to keep them, until three. We have sold a few draught foals. I certainly think that the market for draught foals is much stronger than it is for the traditional cross. I suppose there's a perception that the draught foal is maybe easier managed and easier raised.

We haven't really used the sales up to this, we have sold privately. I suppose we tend

to aim for the UK as the market, and we sold a few horses into the UK - some that we produced as well as some that we bred. Then it is whether they're going to show or go the eventing route. And I suppose there seems to have been an upsurge in the last year or two with the quality of the horses going to the sales, especially in Goresbridge, and the kind of prices that are being returned from Goresbridge.

So certainly, it's something that we would consider using in the future. And I think the marketing that Goresbridge are now doing is fantastic. So I suppose when you're working like we are it's hard to find the time for showing horses to people. And if you're showing them multiple times or you're bringing them off for people to ride somewhere, that kind of thing, particularly in the winter, it can be hard to do that in daylight hours, so that's kind of the attraction, I suppose, of sending them to the sales as well."

What stallions have contributed to your TIH breeding program?

S: *"Well, more recently, I suppose Carrick Diamond Royale that I mentioned, who is owned and bred by Tom Jones, is the only stallion. He's out show jumping at the moment, so he's building a performance record. And, you know, as well as having a jump and a lovely step, he also has fantastic temperament that he's definitely passed on to the foals that we've had by him. In the past, we have used Jackaroo (ISH), who's owned by William Micklem, and we've used Cruising Encore (ISH)[TIH] on one of our draught mares. We got a lovely foal by him that we sold to the UK.*

He'd probably be a lovely show horse. We've used Watermill Swatch (TB) a couple of times as well."

Stallions for this year?

S: *"We're using Carrick Diamond Royal again on the same mare. And we're using Steeped In Luck (ID) this year on our traditional mare. He's an Irish Draught Dressage stallion. I think in the future, probably, if we were looking to use a full thoroughbred stallion on any of our draught mares, we might go with Gibeon"*

If you could have bred any TIH, what would you like to have bred, and why?

S: *"I suppose I'd have to say Cruising, given he was probably nearly the original TIH. And he's had a huge influence, obviously, on Irish pedigrees, at every level and in every discipline. And he's left a huge legacy, especially, I think, on our dam lines. Our traditional mare is a is out of a Cruising mare. So they certainly bring something special to the party."*





Stallions

A total of 846 stallions have had at least 1 TIH foal since 2017, 126 of these have been designated ISH [TIH] themselves. These stallions have been defined as the “Active” Stallion population and each has been assessed for their inbreeding, pedigree completeness, and Thoroughbred percentage. These statistics are outlined in the below table.

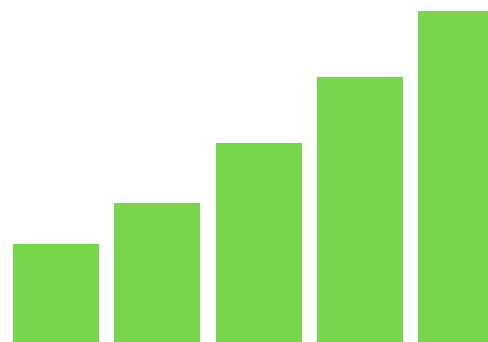
