Edenagor Star



Stallion in Focus

Edenagor Star is a Class 1 Irish Draught stallion bred by Jim McNulty and owned by William McMahon and Grace Maxwell–Murphy. After earning Class 1 status at the 2023 Stallion Selections, he went on to win the Irish Draught Stallion Class at the RDS Dublin Horse Show and later became Champion Irish Draught Stallion. He also made history as the first Irish Draught stallion to qualify for the Horse of the Year Show, where he finished eighth. Admired for his traditional type, bone, and movement, Edenagor Star is already producing quality foals and is seen as a promising contributor to the future of the Irish Draught breed.

Stallion in Focus

Carrabeg The Full Irish is a traditionally bred 2019 Irish Sport Horse stallion bred by Susan Malee. Carefully produced, he progressed from national young horse classes to international competition in Valkenswaard, jumping clear in both qualifiers. In 2025 he earned Preliminary Approval at the Irish Sport Horse Stallion Selections and moved up to 1.30m level. Now seven, he has 90 SJI points and continues to develop with a consistent competitive record and strong traditional bloodlines.
