**Board Summary Report of Key Decisions from the**  
**July 2026 Board meeting**

Dear Affiliates, Stakeholder Groups and members of the Equestrian Community,

The Board of Horse Sport Ireland held its most recent board meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> July 2026 in HSI Head Office, Naas.

Recent resolutions taken and discussions on this occasion relevant to the equestrian community are listed below.

1. The Board received an update from the Chair of the Audit & Risk Committee on current matters.
2. The Board agreed that in the context of the HSI Strategy 2030, a review of the Terms of Reference and population of the High-Performance Advisory Groups across the disciplines should be undertaken to ensure these forums continue to deliver value. The review process will commence in the autumn following the summer competition and championship season and will include stakeholder engagement as part of the process.
3. The Board received updates on the Meitheal Forum, (which took place on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026), recent show attendance and affiliate meetings, together with the upcoming RDS which commences on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2026 and the FEI World Championships in Aachen from 11<sup>th</sup> August.
4. The Board received the Report of the HSI Anti-Doping Officer/Medical Officer 2025 – 2026.
5. The Board were provided with updates from the Advisory Forums by the Industry representative Board Members, together with receiving copies of the minutes of the recently held meetings.
