For the loose jumping pony competition there will be a height restriction based on the measurement of the height at the withers which cannot exceed a maximum of 151.0cm with shoes on the day of competition.

Ponies may enter multiple competitions, however if a prize is won at any competition, you will not be permitted to compete at a further competition. In the event of a tie, the pony with the highest score for 'Technique' will be the winner. Ponies may be called back into the arena to jump a bigger fence before the final adjudication at the judge's discretion.
