I note that HSI may use the horse data supplied for studbook purposes, breed improvement research and future promotion of the breed and that it may be used in HSI publications, media outlets and online platforms.

I understand that my details will be entered in the Identity Document (passport), on the Irish Horse Register and on the National Equine Database. This statement is made in compliance with SI 201 of 2016 and a false, misleading or incomplete declaration is liable to the penal provisions of the Animal Health and Welfare Act 2013.

This form is used for the naming or change of registered name of an animal in the Irish Horse Register.

Please note:

1. Animals named with a prefix cannot have their name changed without written permission from the Principal Prefix Licencee.
2. Animals who have recorded progeny can only have their name changed if all passports for progeny are returned with the application form.

Other information

Equine Premises Number - It is a legal requirement under the Control on Places where Horses are kept Regulations (SI 113 of 2014) that all premises where equines are kept must be registered with the Department of Agriculture. Accordingly, you should ensure that your equine is being kept on a registered premises. If your holding is not already registered as an Equine Premises, you should apply immediately to DAFM for an Equine Premises Number.

Further points to note:

1. The passport is not a deed of ownership
2. This document is a legal declaration (with penalties under the Animal Health and Welfare Act 2013.)
3. It is a legal requirement that the document of Identification (passport) should always accompany the equine.
