Arena: 80m x 40m.

Marathon: 3 Sections with 6 obstacles, no water. Section A of approximately 8k on road and relatively flat; Untimed transfer; Section B approximately 6k on flat farmland tracks.

Obstacle Cone Driving: Obstacle Fault Competition. Axles to be extended to appropriate width.

All competitors must be members of HSI/CDI or NICDA. All competitors must have their own personal insurance that covers competitive driving trials events and includes third party cover.

Close of entries: Wednesday July 21st

Entry fee: €60 all classes except Crystal Combination. Crystal Combination €10.

Parking: Parking available beside the cones and dressage fields. Wide gates for large lorries.

Results: There will be no results or prizегiving on the day. They will be posted online after the event.

Directions: The event location is on the outskirts of Donard, Co Wicklow. Donard is a very central location and is approximately 40 minutes from the M50 Tallaght exit.

Please use Eircode **W91 RY84** which will take you directly to the entrance gates of the event.

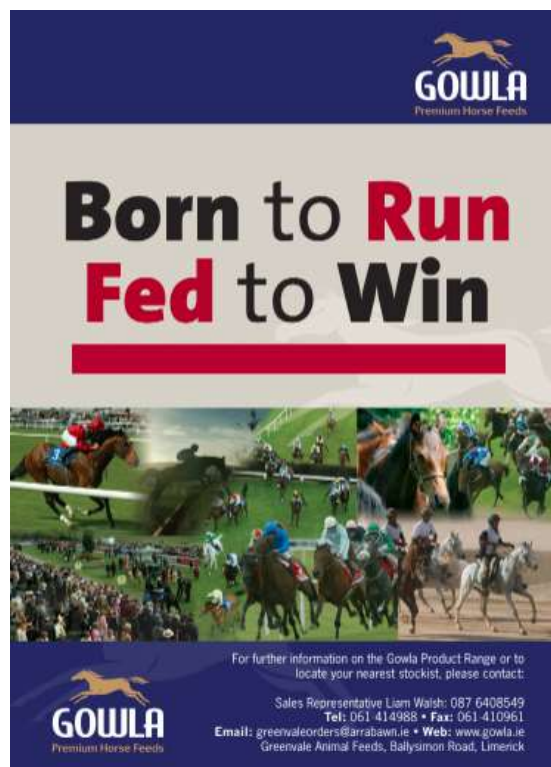
