



Embryo Transfer Scheme 2022 Eligibility, Terms & Conditions

(*If you've received funding before for this scheme before, please see Appendix 1A before completing)

Horse Sport Ireland are delighted to re-launch the Embryo Transfer scheme in 2022. This initiative is supported by the Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine. Please note that the closing date for receipt of applications is **5.00pm on Friday 30th September 2022 this deadline is final and will not be extended**. Applications will be deemed to be invalid if they are incomplete or do not contain the relevant supporting documentation. Applications must be submitted to the online application form. Before completing this application form, please read the Eligibility Criteria (Appendix 1), the Donor Mare Performance and/or Progeny Performance Criteria (Appendix 2a or 2b for TIH applicants if oversubscribed) and ensure that you have submitted all of the supporting documentation outlined in the checklist (Appendix 3).

Appendix 1: Terms and Conditions of the HSI Embryo Transfer Scheme

- Applicants must be the registered owner of the donor mare(s) subject to the application.
- Applicants must be resident in Ireland and can apply for a maximum of two ET's.
- This scheme operates on a first come first served basis up to the maximum allocation facilitated by the existing budget allocation. Horse Sport Ireland reserve the right to close the scheme prior to the advertised deadline.
- Provision of funding is subject to a complete feedback form on completion of the scheme
- **NEW** A requirement for this Scheme in 2022 is the applicant must provide Horse Sport Ireland with proof of registration of the foal in a Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine (DAFM) Approved Studbook. Foals must obtain a passport before 31st December of the year of birth or within 6 months following the date of its birth, whichever occurs later. If this is not provided the applicant will be exempt from this scheme for the following three years (2023-2025).
- Donor mares must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:
 - Be registered/endorsed in a DAFM approved studbook.
 - Be three years old or more.
 - Meet veterinary requirements of the initial examination at the *Designated Veterinary Clinic as required.
 - Provide verified results demonstrating that the mare meets the performance and/or progeny performance criteria outlined in Appendix 2. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the donor mare meets the performance requirement. Applications received without verified results will not be processed.
- Traditional Irish Horse donor mares must meet all the following eligibility criteria:
 - \circ $\;$ Be registered/endorsed in a DAFM approved studbook.
 - Be three years old or more.
 - Meet veterinary requirements of the initial examination at the *Designated Veterinary Clinic as required.
 - (And if oversubscribed will need to submit below performance)
 - Provide verified results demonstrating that the mare meets the performance and/or progeny performance criteria outlined in Appendix 2a.





- The Embryo Transfer procedure **MUST** be carried out at a veterinary clinic which is designated for this scheme and **MUST** take place after the 1st March and an application must be submitted before the 30th September 2022 and the verification of pregnancy must be received by HSI by 14th October 2022.
- In exceptional circumstances HSI will consider applications on a case-by-case basis from overseas veterinary clinics where the donor and recipient mares are based in Ireland.
- HSI will consider pony embryo transfer applications on a case-by-case basis.
- Semen used for the embryo transfers **MUST** be from Stallions which are Approved in a WBFSH/DAFM Studbook or a Pony Studbook approved by DAFM.
- Semen used for the Traditional Irish Horse embryo transfers **MUST** be from Stallions recorded as Traditional/TB which are Approved in a WBFSH/DAFM approved Studbook.
- In the event of oversubscription to the program the awarding of the grant will be allocated to the donor mare with the best performance ratings or EBV's and to ensure that a sufficient balance across the disciplines is achieved.
- HSI reserve the right to use performance standard equivalents.
- The recipient mare must meet the veterinary requirements of the initial examination at the Designated Veterinary Clinic as required (this includes checking the mare's microchip).
 Recipient mares are required to be registered and if no microchip is located the veterinary surgeon during the initial examination will have to insert a microchip and complete markings for registration.
- In order to draw down the €1,500 payment per embryo applicants MUST
 - submit proof of payment for the Embryo Transfer procedure by the 14th October 2022,
 AND
 - A zootechnical certificate for the Embryo signed and stamped by the Designated Veterinary Clinic by the 14th October 2022, AND
 - Conformation that the recipient has been scanned 60 days in foal, signed and stamped by a Veterinary Surgeon by the 14th October 2022.
 AND
 - Submission of payment details
 AND
 - Completion of Feedback form
 - Once the above supporting documentation has been received payment of €1,500 will be transferred to account details provided in 2022

PLEASE NOTE: Applicants must comply with Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine legislation for equine foal passport registrations to be eligible to participate in future Embryo Transfer Schemes. Proof will be required.

Horse Sport Ireland reserves the right to use performance equivalents and will consider breeding values from other studbooks on a case-by-case basis.

Horse Sport Ireland reserve the right to change, amend or update scheme terms and conditions. In the event of same, existing applicants will be notified.
