



## Horse Sport Ireland - End of Year Review

### National Equine Anti-Doping Programme Summary 2021

The period under review in this report is 1st January 2021 – 31st December 2021. During this time the Horse Sport Ireland Equine Anti-Doping Programme carried out 114 tests.
