Registration of a prefix

- Horse Sport Ireland is offering breeders/owners the facility to register a prefix with Horse Sport
 Ireland for a fee of €62/£56. This facility is optional you need not accept it if you so wish. The prefix
 should be a geographical name or a distinctive word or name. A prefix may have a maximum of 20
 letters, and two word prefixes are not accepted. Initials can be accepted, with a minimum of three
 letters. Breed names are not allowed.
- 2. New prefixes should be registered in the name of the principal owner (followed by additional users where applicable). All correspondence should be with the principal owner i.e. in the event of a dispute
- 3. The individual names of users of the prefix must be stated in the form overleaf. Please note that it is advisable to mention all the individuals (i.e. members of the family) that will use the prefix as there is a cost to add names to the ownership of the prefix once the certificate of ownership of the prefix has been issued. One Person must be named as the primary prefix holder. In cases of dispute this person will be the primary contact.
- 4. The fee of €62 is a once off payment. There is however an additional charge of €43 if a change is made to the prefix, or if there is a change of ownership of the prefix.
- 5. <u>Very Important!</u> Breeders/owners who already use a particular prefix will be given priority with regard to being allocated that prefix, provided that they return the application form within two weeks of receipt of this communication. Otherwise, it cannot be guaranteed that the prefix will be available.
- 6. Please be advised, due to Article 138 of the FEI rules the FEI may change the original studbook name including the prefix on the FEI Recognition Card. This is beyond our control.

ARTICLE 138 - Names of Horses

- 1. In principle, the first registered name of a Horse entered in the passport shall be the original name under which it was originally registered by its NF, and this name must remain permanently in the passport.
- 2. The first registered name may not be the name of a commercial company or product. If this name is considered to be the name of a commercial company or product, a new first registered name must be entered and remain permanently in the passport.
- 3. A commercial prefix or suffix may be added to the name mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 2 above and must be entered in the passport. However, at Regional and Olympic Games under the patronage of the IOC, such prefix or suffix cannot appear in a programme or be used in any other way.
- 4. If a new first name shall be used and entered in the passport and/or the commercial prefix/suffix be changed, the Horse must carry the new name and/or the new prefix/suffix for the next twelve (12) months as follows: new name and/or new prefix/suffix ex previous name/prefix/ suffix (see VRs). "
