Driven Dressage: Dressage tests for 2023 apply. see BC website: <u>https://www.britishcarriagedriving.co.uk/dressage/index.htm</u>. Arena: Grass 80m x 40m.

Marathon: 3 Sections with 3 obstacles, including water Obstacle. A controlled warm up to be used as an alternative to the traditional section A. Section B approximately 3km on flat farmland. Cool down area immediately after section B.

Obstacle Cone Driving: Obstacle Fault Competition. Axles are not required to be extended.

All competitors must be members of HSI/CDI or NICDA. All competitors must have their own personal insurance that covers competitive driving trials events and includes third party cover.

Close of entries: Tuesday 5th September 4.30pm

Entry fee: €55 plus "Plain sailing" booking fee all classes except Crystal Combination. Crystal Combination €10.

Parking: Parking available on designated grass area. Please park where directed to assist with organising. Wide gates for large lorries.

Stabling available on a first come and first served basis. **€40 per stable per night**, Shaving is provided. Book with John Kennedy prior to event, payment made at venue to Joe Ponsoby on arrival. Stables to have Horse droppings removed on departure You can corral on site should you wish.
