FEI Event Application Form 2024

Guidelines

Horse Sport Ireland invite Organising Committee's to submit an application to host an international FEI Level Event.

The deadline for submissions for the 2024 FEI Calendar is Monday 18th September 2023.

Organising Committees should note the following:

- Prior to submitting an application for international calendar dates, it is recommended that the OC's engage with the relevant Affiliate to ensure that the date sought is compatible with the relevant Affiliate national calendar.
- Late additions and modifications to the FEI calendar may be subject to a fee.
- Lower-level events (see table in Financial Charges **2024**) may be added to the calendar at any stage without additional cost.
- Please note that the FEI Organising Dues and the Horse Sport Ireland levy on FEI prize funds are invoiced after all the FEI events and are payable within 30 days from the date of invoice. Late interest applies thereafter as per the FEI Financial Charges.
- Receipt of this application shall not be construed as a guarantee that a FEI calendar date will be granted. Moreover, in applying for the chosen dates the Organising Committee agrees to abide by the rules of the FEI from the date in which the calendar application is approved to the end date of the event. The OC understands that the failure to adhere to the FEI General Regulations may constitute a violation of the FEI General Regulations.
- Please note that the FEI calendar approvals are non-transferable to another OC.
- Jumping Event Organising Committees are reminded of the FEI Jumping Rules Article 200.6.2 with regard to FEI Officials.

Declaration

FEI ORGANISING DUES – Invoiced by the FEI after the event

1. Organising Dues

1.1 Organising dues will be charged on the basis of the total amount of prizes

in cash and in-kind convertible into cash according to the scale shown below:	on amounts up to	CHF	149'999
• 4.7%			
• 4.2%	on amounts from	CHF	150'000 to 249'999
• 3.0%	on amounts from	CHF	250'000 to 499'999
• 2.5%	on amounts from	CHF	500'000 to 799'999
• 2.0%	on amounts from	CHF	800'000 to 999'999
• 1.0%	on amounts above	CHF	1'000'000

2. Minimum Organising Dues

The following minimum fees will be imposed for events without prize-money or with a prize amount lower than CHF 10'600:

- For all disciplines

CHF 500

- For lower-level events

3. Fee for Worldwide Equine and Human Anti-Doping Program

(Applicable for all FEI Events Worldwide)		
<u>Lower Level Events (CIMs)</u> (For definition see Appendix E of the FEI General Regulations) Per horse per event (for Driving per Turnout* per event)	CHF	18
<u>Higher Level Events</u> (All other events not defined as CIM) Per horse per event (for Driving per Turnout* per event)	CHF	25

* (at some events, drivers may compete more than once with a different set of horses)

OCs/NFs have the right to charge the competitors the above mentioned fee.
