There was a welcome return of the number one ranking for the Irish Sport Horse Studbook in the WBFSH Eventing rankings, with the results for both Le Lion D'Angers and Lanaken on page 21.

## Teacher and international show jumping sensation, Jessica Burke is an inspiration to the next generation

Jessica Burke's swift rise to the top of show jumping has been nothing short of inspirational – from teaching maths in the classroom to counting strides in the five-star arena, the Galway girl is proof that chasing your dreams can lead to living them.

After a confidence-building Horse of the Year Show hat-trick in Birmingham last October courtesy of Irish Sport Horse, Express Trend, and her wonderful mare, Inpulss (KWPN), Jessica has landed five-star wins across the globe, including in Sharjah this February, and has danced at the big dances: four- and five-star Nations Cups.

### Rising Up The Ranks

Jessica enjoyed plenty of success competing within the pony ranks and represented Ireland at two consecutive Pony European Championships. However, she applied herself to academia and chose a career as an educator. It's in recent years that she turned to show jumping as a full-time career. This decision has proven to be an inspired one, with wins at the highest level and the icing on the cake of her call-up to the senior Nations Cup teams this winter with Nikey HH (BWP).

"I suppose you could say it's going well," Jessica says, with an air of calm confidence. She is instantly engaging, relaxed and warm. First impressions would suggest this is a woman comfortable in her own skin. Almost overnight, she has become the poster girl for women's show jumping in Ireland.

"I don't know about that – that's funny to even think that way," Jessica responds. Her career and its recent trajectory were not an overnight thing. She has been building towards this and took a massive leap of faith.

"I had a great career in Ponies. But we didn't really own any of the ponies I was competing on, so we bought a horse with the aim of competing with her and she was okay. But then she got injured, and I didn't really have any good horses. I did my Leaving Cert and went to college because that's just what I thought you do. I enjoyed college but I probably didn't have enough belief in myself to go and do this either."

### Making the Move

Fast forward a few years, and the start of something special for Jessica: her future star performer Express Trend (ISH) and his owner and breeder Liam Nicholas. "I suppose it started with Express Trend – I won the four- and six-year-olds in Dublin in 2017 but at that stage it was still always only young horses that I was dealing with," she says.

"Then I went to Lanaken and caught a glimpse of the international circuit. I travelled to compete in Lier and Sentower during school holidays and saw more of it. Then I had Express Trend, and he was clear in a two-star Grand Prix. Loads of people were ringing me up to buy him. I didn't know the buzz of the whole industry, all I had seen was Ireland, I knew the young horse side of it. I had a good horse and a good owner behind me in Liam. That's when I said 'right, that's the end of the teaching.'"

Now a five-star Nations Cup team member and a five-star winner individually, Jessica has come a long way since becoming a full-time professional.

### Right Horses, Right Time

As is the case with most things, timing can be everything and Jessica rode the right horses at the right time, helping to put her on her current trajectory.

In 2017 she landed a double at the Dublin Horse Show. Jessica claimed the four-year-old title aboard the Irish Sport Horse mare Lux A Special Lady and the six-year-old title with the stallion Castlclawn Captain Junior (ISH)[TIH].

Later that year, she made her senior debut at the FEI WBFSH World Breeding Jumping Championship for Young Horses in Lanaken, Belgium, competing Castlclawn Captain Junior (ISH)[TIH] in the six-year-old division and Express Trend (ISH) in the seven-year-olds.

Sired by Captain Clover (ISH)[TIH] and out of the mare Diroe (ISH)[TIH] by Diamond Lad (ID), Castlclawn Captain Junior (ISH)[TIH] is a half-brother to Bahrain Silver (ISH)[TIH] by Bahrain Cruise (ISH)[TIH], who competed successfully at 1.50m with

British rider Ben Talbot, and Luxroe (ISH) by Lux Z (HANN) who also competed internationally with Irish rider Eddie Moloney. Lux Z (HANN) also sired Lux A Special Lady (ISH). Her full sister Special Lux (ISH), jumped up to 1.60m. She was campaigned by Ireland's Anthony Condon with fellow Irish rider Jonathan McCrea later taking over the ride. Special Lux (ISH) was second in a 1.60m GP Spruce Meadows in 2014 and featured on Nations Cup teams for Ireland in Coapexpan, Mexico, and Langley, Canada.

Bred by Dessie Judge, Lux A Special Lady (ISH) and Special Lux (ISH) are out of Aisling Clover (ISH)[TIH], by Coille Mor Hill (ID). Dessie proved a great supporter of Jessica, giving her the ride on Lux A Special Lady (ISH) in Lanaken in 2019.

Another horse who helped to bring Jessica onto the international stage was Orestus Clover, an Irish Sport Horse mare by Orestus (KWPN), out of the Clover Hill (ID) mare Optimistic Clover (ISH). Jessica competed her in the five- and six-year-old divisions in Lanaken in 2018 and 2019.

Orestus Clover (ISH) is a half-sister to the dam of Castlefield Vegas (ISH) by Cassino (SWWB). Castlefield Vegas (ISH) was a member of two winning Nations Cups teams for Ireland with Gerard O'Neill.

Express Trend has helped Jessica get to where she is and the now 13-year-old gelding is by Future Trend (OLD) and out of

the mare Condios Express (ISH), by Condios (HOLST).

Jessica and Express Trend have recorded a series of top results on the international circuit, including winning the 1.55m Winning Round class at the CSI5\* in Sharjah, UAE in February of this year. In October 2022, they won the Masters at the CSI4\* in St. Lo, France, and in 2020 the Grand Prix at the CSI2\* in Sentower Park, Belgium.

### Role Model

Growing up, Jessica was inspired by the likes of Jessica Kürten – an Irish woman with the same name who proved a catalyst for what was to come years later. "I would wonder, could I do that? She reached number two in the world and was nearly number one at one point."

The last female rider to represent Ireland in the Nations Cup in Dublin was Nicola Fitzgibbon in 2011. With her steely determination, Jessica Burke is aiming to be next Irish female rider to be on a winning team on Aga Khan day at the Dublin Horse Show.

Jessica embraces the fact that her success may inspire the next generation of girls who dare to dream. "Life is too short to not try and do what you want to do. Look at me, even since I left teaching! Follow your passion, because anything is possible once you believe in it and work hard."



# Family fortunes

**Cheryl Broderick speaks to Horse Sport Ireland about her role in the family business and the support she has experienced working in the Irish Sport Horse industry**

For five generations, the Broderick family has been farming at Ballypatrick in Co. Tipperary, an operation which has evolved into a multi-faceted enterprise with two farms. Fortwilliam is the Broderick's breeding operation, with six resident stallions and some of the best-bred mares in the world, while Ballypatrick has state-of-the-art training and competition facilities as well as a multinational sales operation.

Cheryl Broderick heads up the breeding operation at Ballypatrick and there is no doubt that she loves what she does: working closely with her family to help produce top international horses is a dream for many. "I'm very lucky to work alongside my family every day, and to be part of the history of Ballypatrick. I'm lucky to get up every day and do what I love," Cheryl explains. "It's nice that we have our own niche here at Ballypatrick, we're part of the one business, but it's opened up and expanded. I'm in the breeding, Olga my sister is in the office and runs the accounts, and Greg is extremely busy with show jumping, sales and training students. It's evolved that we all have our own roles."

Cheryl is one of Ireland's most successful breeders. Last year she won the Leading Breeder's Prize at the RDS Dublin Horse Show while homebred BP Goodfellas, ridden by Gerard O'Neill, won gold in the five-year-old FEI WBFSH World Breeding Jumping Championship for Young Horses in Lanaken, Belgium.

Speaking about the success of last year, Cheryl adds:

"Everybody wants to be Leading Breeder at the Dublin Horse Show and that was always something that I aimed myself towards. I was knocking on the door a couple of times and last year I won it, which was brilliant."

"When you look down through the list of people who have won it before me, they are from very good yards and very good breeders producing great horses so it's nice to be included among those. After Dublin, we went to the World Breeding Championship in Belgium, where our homebred horse, BP Goodfellas, won gold. So, I think 2022 is probably a year that I will remember for a long time."

## Supportive Environment

When asked if Cheryl had any advice for women looking to get involved in breeding, she says: "If you look at the equestrian arena in Ireland, there's an awful lot of women that you can look up to and be inspired by. I think that for any woman coming into the sport it's a brilliant game to be involved in. You meet such great people and there is great camaraderie between us."

Cheryl is pragmatic that breeding is not always easy and requires its fair share of time and effort. "Breeding is hard, it's not a simple life. It involves a lot of long hours, and you don't see your rewards until further on in your career, but I think it's

worth every bit of it. The enjoyment you get from a homebred winning a class and going on to do good things, I think nothing can compare to it," she continues.

For both men and women involved in the industry, it's vital to have the right support systems in place. Cheryl works closely with Horse Sport Ireland, benefiting from various breeding schemes and incentives. "For a big yard like ours where we're breeding between a large number of foals per year you have a huge interaction with HSI – the breeding department and registrations are particularly helpful to us," she adds.

## Combined Effort

The Ballypatrick business model works by playing to individual strengths and working towards a common goal. For Cheryl, one of the most important relationships to keep the business moving

in the right direction is between her as the breeder and the riders. "I think as a breeder you need to work with the riders. It's an expensive game to breed and produce your horse, so getting advice from riders about your horse early in their career can be a great insight.

"As foals in the fields, Greg watches each of them, looking for different characteristics; balance, canter, type. When we loose jump them as three-year-olds we watch their technique, scope, canter, and balance. When they are ridden as young horses, Kevin Gallagher and Greg focus on their rideability: Are they uphill? What is the feeling they give them over the fence? They also assess what the horse's potential and potential market could be.

"It's interesting to see the horses that suit the different riders, one might be better for Kevin or possibly for Niamh McEvoy or Leah Stack, who are both such talented riders themselves. I'm lucky to have an Olympian as a brother and Kevin, who was National Champion, alongside me, day in day out, and I think their expertise has helped me become a better breeder."

### Pride of Place

Cheryl is undoubtably proud to be a woman involved in such a successful business and her role within its growth. Success at Ballypatrick has been based around utilising the resources they have and the benefits of producing horses in Ireland. She is very positive about the benefits they have earned from producing their young horses through the HSI aged classes, and Studbook Series. "I find that HSI and the Studbook classes have been instrumental in the production of our young horses. Any of the horses that have gone on to do good things for us all came through the Studbook Series. Whether it's the young horse classes in the preparation for Lanaken, I think they're essential and I think they're a great grounding for any breeder that wants to develop their horses in the right direction," she continues.

From the perspective of the breeder, knowing and understanding the requirements of the current sport is vital. "We need to breed modern horses that are commercial worldwide.

Breeders should go to watch the HSI classes, to see the young horses, use Clipmyhorse to stay up to date with show jumping worldwide. These tools are invaluable to breeders to keep an eye on what pedigrees are consistently coming through, what mare lines are producing good jumpers, and what stallions are consistently breeding the most commercial top showjumpers." Cheryl believes that there are few places as good as Ireland to produce young horses. "In Ireland we're very lucky, it's a country that is known for the production of young horses. We have good countryside, with good land and the horses have a great way of being brought up here.

"You can get lots of mileage into your horses without ever having to leave Ireland. If you look at Greg's Olympic horse, MHS Going Global, he never left the country until he went to international level. He came up through the Studbook Series and all the young horse classes. We have the best riders in the world so it's up to us as breeders to keep breeding top horses for them!"

# Training Day

**After two decades, the Young Breeders programme is going from strength to strength, writes Wendy Conlon**

Teagasc and Horse Sport Ireland, with support from the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine have invested in the education and encouragement of young people for almost 20 years through the Young Breeders programme. The programme reaped – competitively speaking – its highest accolade in 2022 at the International Young Breeder WBFSH World Championship in The Netherlands where the Irish team was crowned Studbook World Champions from a field of 20 studbooks, represented by 139 competitors.

Additionally, the Junior team emerged first in its age class, and the Senior team was ranked third in its division. Individually, Juniors Aoife Kirby and Shane Donohoe landed podium positions, in second and third place, respectively.

The programme focuses predominantly on assessing conformation and athleticism traits, with focus on 'in hand presentation' of horses and the theory test closer to championships. Any interested 15–25-year-olds can attend training, whether motivated by competitive ambitions or not. Although the format is repeated, each farm visited is unique, with different horses to view and discuss. Where a farm is re-visited, usually different horses are available to view, so the learning continues.

Success hinges on the wider industry collaboration; choice of farms with appropriate quality of horses; openness of the trainers working alongside Teagasc Equine Specialists; and also the input of those who have been through the programme previously and are willing to help out and give back when it comes to the big events like National Championships. The contribution of everyone involved is valued and appreciated. The 2023 training programme kicked off in February with a visit to both Coolmore Stud and Fethard Equine Hospital. Jason Walsh and Conor Higgins guided the large group, who had travelled from all corners of the country, around the stud.

The highlight, after viewing the stallions while discussing their management and the protocols around covering and attention to detail with the pre- and post-mating management of mares, was undoubtedly the very special privilege of walking around the museum of treasures, memorabilia, and life-like replica of Saddlers Wells.

A tour of Fethard Equine Hospital guided by its equine surgeon, Ann Derham, followed. The group was able to see where and how horses are sedated for surgery, discussed the typical procedures, and received a fabulous insight into the various diagnostic tools used at the clinic. Ann shared her study and career path, answering several questions on what it is like to be one of only a very small number of female equine surgeons in

the country, and offering encouragement to those with similar interests to follow their dreams.

The second training event of 2023 took place at the Army Equitation School in McKee Barracks, Dublin. Comdt. Tom Freyne and his colleagues provided a superb display of horses and horsemanship. The session began by viewing a selection of horses at different stages of production and different models in the flesh without tack.

Subsequently, the group witnessed a selection of ridden horses demonstrating the traits, character and rideability demanded by the sport of show jumping. Most evident to all was the attention to detail, and sympathetic approach of the production system at the school.

Another training day took place on May 6th at Atlantic Stables, Kilcolgan, Co. Galway, home to show jumper Aoife McCabe and her string of horses. It was followed by a visit to Edie Murray Hayden's Gormanstown Stud near Kilcullen, Co. Kildare on May 27th.

Further dates for the summer will be announced shortly. Selection for next year's World Championship team to travel to Denmark will commence in the autumn so those with an eye on that goal should get involved now to give themselves every chance of achieving it. # Irish Sport Horse Studbook Top Eventing & Show Jumping Rankings for 2022

The Irish Sport Horse (ISH) studbook reclaimed its place as the leading World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSH) studbook for eventing horses in 2022, moving up from third place in 2021.

The WBFSH rankings also show that the ISH has maintained its top 10 placing for show jumping horses, having had the same position in 2021. In an even more positive development, the six horses, whose individual ranking count towards the overall studbook score, all placed within the top 25 internationally for event horses, and the top 100 for show jumpers.

"Horse Sport Ireland would like to congratulate the breeders, owners and riders of the horses who contributed to the success of the Irish Sport Horse in 2022 and their ranking, as well as to the connections of all horses who represent the Irish Sport Horse worldwide," said Head of Breeding, Development and Innovation, Sonja Egan.

## Irish Sport Horse EIC Cooley Jump The Q wins first 5\* Grand Prix

Irish Sport Horse EIC Cooley Jump The Q's Grand Prix win in January's CSI5\* Grand Prix in Basel, Switzerland with Austrian rider Max Kühner was the perfect start to the new year for Co. Carlow breeder Pam Walshe.

It was the second international victory for this horse and rider combination and the first at five-star level. In January 2022, they recorded their first international win at the CSI2\* in Opglabbeek, Belgium.

The Pacino-sired bay 10-year-old gelding was bred by Pam Walshe and comes from a long and successful dam line.

Speaking to Horse Sport Ireland, Pam explained how her father, John Walshe, started this breeding journey. "It's a really good story that's come from five generations of homebreds, and it makes it all worthwhile."

Like many Irish breeders, Pam does not have a big breeding operation, so she focuses her efforts on maintaining this successful dam line. "We're very lucky that it's a dam line that no-one else has, we keep all of the nice fillies and then sell on the colts, usually as three-year-olds. When you look at EIC Cooley Jump The Q's (ISH) pedigree, we bred every mare on the dam line, and that's really something."

### Dam Line

There is no doubting Pam's pride when she talks of EIC Cooley Jump The Q. January's result was the culmination of generations of hard work and perseverance. Pam's father started the dam line in the 1970s. He bred the first three generations before Pam bred the two most recent generations. EIC Cooley Jump The Q is the first of five foals out of Jump The Q (ISH). Pam is excited to have two mares to carry on the next generation of the dam line: six-year-old Cornet Q (ISH) by Cornet Obolensky (BWP) and Casall Q (ISH), a yearling by Casall Le Silla (HOLST).

Jump The Q is by OBOS Quality 004 (OLD), out of Abbey Emerald (ISH), by Positively (TB). Jump The Q jumped up to 1.30m with Pam's sister Tracy before she became a broodmare. Pam explained how there is a running joke within the family that her father tried to sell Abbey Emerald as a young horse but thankfully was unsuccessful. She stayed in the yard and went on to be competed by Pam in the Amateur show jumping ranks.

Jump The Q is a full sister to Mark Q (ISH) who jumped up to 1.60m with Irish rider Kevin Babington, including recording three international wins. Mark Q was produced in Ireland until he was an eight-year-old.

### Star Quality

Pam admits that EIC Cooley Jump The Q has always had something special about him. "Even as a two-year-old, when most horses are in that ugly phase, he was different, he always stood out," she said.

To date, the first-born foals have been the stars of the show for Pam's breeding operation. Mark Q was Abbey Emerald's first foal and EIC Cooley Jump the Q was Jump The Q's first foal. EIC Cooley Jump The Q made his debut at the RDS Loose Jumping qualifier as a three-year-old in Warrington Equestrian Centre where he was spotted and bought by Richard Sheane of Cooley Farm. He was produced by Cooley Farm, including winning in the four-year-old Final at Cavan Equestrian Centre with rider Katie O'Sullivan.

He made his way to Kühner and then, as the saying goes, the rest is history. The pair made their international debut in Donauveschingen-Immenhöfe, Germany in August 2019. Since then, this combination has gone from strength to strength, with over 120 international starts and 35 top 10 finishes recorded prior to their 5\* victory.

Speaking about his 5\* success, Richard said: "We're delighted but not at all surprised. I saw him jump one fence and knew he was going to be a superstar. Success though, only comes with good riders and Max has done an excellent job on him."

### Much Appreciated Supports

Pam and her family have a long history of breeding and producing horses. Although they have enjoyed success with their breeding operation, she is very open that it does not come without its challenges.

Recently, Pam has availed of the HSI Embryo Transfer Scheme with Jump The Q. Her most recent foal was an embryo transfer, and this year she is expecting another through embryo transfer by Emerald (BWP).

Speaking about the supports on offer, Pam said: "It's thanks to the Embryo Transfer grant, it really makes all the difference. It really helps to reduce some of the costs of breeding horses." Pam is very much looking forward to seeing what the future holds for EIC Cooley Jump The Q and this result has certainly put him on the map for 2023 and beyond.

# We are improving equine DNA analysis

In 2022, Horse Sport Ireland (HSI) announced the Microsatellite (MS) to Single Nucleotide Polymorphism (SNP) DNA transition scheme.

Phase I of the transition saw an invitation to all Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine (DAFM) sport horse studbooks to participate in the scheme, funded under National Breeding Services operated by Horse Sport Ireland (HSI). Participating sport horse studbooks were allocated several SNP tests to generate a 'reference library' of their active breeding herd.

To date, The Connemara Pony Breeders Society, Kerry Bog Pony Co-operative, Irish Harness Racing Association, Leisure Horse Ireland and HSI studbooks (Irish Sport Horse, Irish Sport Pony, Irish Draught, Irish Cob, and Irish Part bred Cob studbooks) have re-analysed almost 10,000 mares and stallions on the SNP technology. This re-sampled population provides the basis for phase II of the project, implementing SNP parentage verification for the 2023 sport horse foal crop.

This is a hugely significant move for the sport horse sector in Ireland; ovine and bovine parentage testing moved from MS to SNP testing in 2009. Equines are the only remaining species using MS for parentage verification. This transition provides Irish breeders with the opportunity to become world leaders in equine genetics, joining the KWPN and German Studbooks.

There are significant advantages to using the SNP technology in horses such as improved accuracy of pedigree, preservation of rare lines, monitoring health-related genes and potential abnormalities, predicting coat colour and, in time, research on other breeding and performance related traits.

## What does this change look like for Irish breeders?

Breeders may receive multiple hair sample bags for submission to their studbook during foal registration - this is normal! You will still need your vet to



mark, and hair sample your foals.

To generate a reliable SNP profile for the foal, it is essential to have the SNP genetic profiles of both parents of the animal. In some cases, only one parent will be SNP technology. This will require sire/dam AND foal hair samples for SNP typing. See our graphic below outlining when an MS test is required.

## ALL HAIR SAMPLES MUST BE RETURNED TO THE PASSPORT-ISSUING ORGANISATION (PIO) AND NOT THE LABORATORY.

Please ensure to submit all hair samples as directed in your foal kit. The Veterinary Council of Ireland and Irish Equine Veterinary Association have been notified of this transition, the potential for multiple sample bags, and to return hair sample bags to the PIO.

## What kind of sample is required?

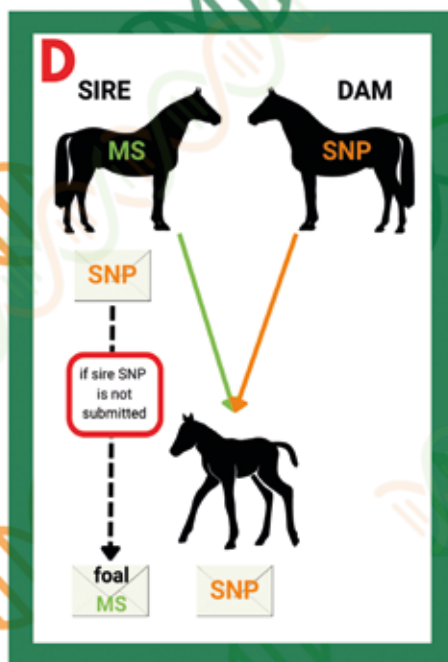
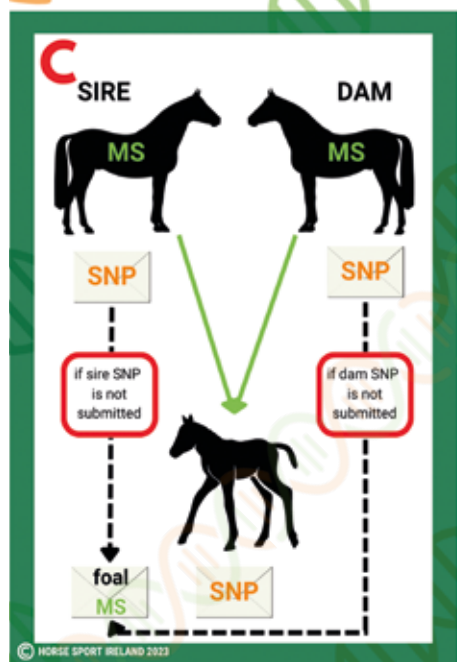
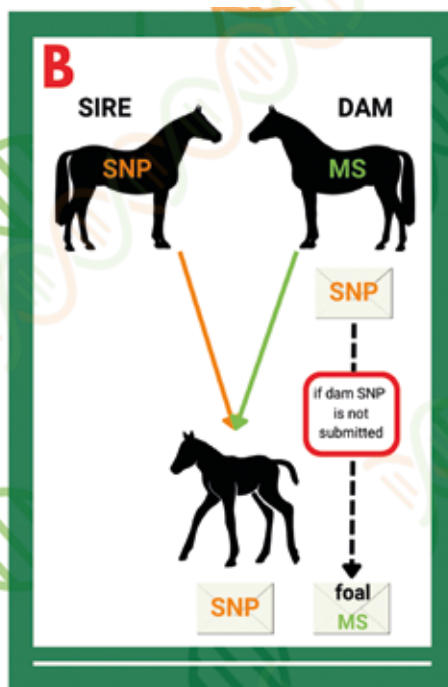
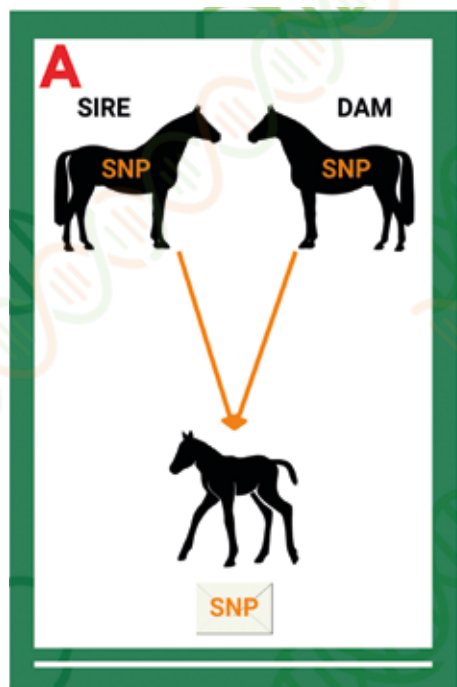
Good hair sampling is imperative for a successful transition. A minimum of 50 clean, intact hairs pulled from the root must be submitted to the PIO for SNP sampling. These hairs must have the follicle/hair blub intact. Please ensure there is no soap or other residue on these hairs.

## What is the cost?

There is no cost to the breeder for SNP testing of the sire, dam or foal. Dam/Sire SNP testing is supported by the DAFM-HSI National Breeding Services at 100%.

Foal SNP typing is supported by the DAFM Equine Technical Support fund at 70%, the other 30% is included in the studbook registration fee. MS technology is no longer supported





by the DAFM and participating sport horse studbooks. If a breeder requires a MS test, they will be required to cover the laboratory cost of €31.50 to the registering studbook. It is important that stallion SNP samples are submitted if requested to prevent this cost to the breeder. If you have already received a request for your stallion hair sample, please return this to the registering studbook as soon as possible.

### How do I know if my mare/stallion was included in the reference library?

It is not possible for any PIO to predict all potential breeding stallions and mares in the reference library. If you are breeding this year and would like to ensure your stallion/mare is on the SNP technology, please fill out the contact form via the QR code below. If they are not included in the reference library, the studbook will

issue the required sample bags. Many PIOs are working to upgrade their websites to offer an online 'G' (SNP genotype) checker function. This will remove the need to request information as you will be able to check this online.

### I am breeding from a non-pregnant OR maiden mare; will she be on SNP?

She may be on the platform if she has foaled in the previous three years OR engaged in previous National Breeding Service schemes. Please fill out our contact form via the QR code to make a request. If they are not included in the reference library, the studbook will issue the required sample bags.

### I am a stallion owner/agent, what do I do?

If you are a stallion owner or agent, you are obliged to ensure that your stallion meets the DNA testing requirements of the studbooks for which the progeny is to be entered. The DAFM has declared that SNP is the DNA platform to be applied by the sport horse sector in Ireland. Please use our contact form via the QR code to determine if a sample is required for the standing stallion(s). This is particularly important for stallions standing abroad, where a hair or semen sample may be required to prevent the additional MS testing cost to breeders who are expecting 2023 foals. If you would like to ensure that your stallion or mare is included in the SNP reference library, please fill out our request form behind the QR code below.

# FEI WBFSH Young Horse Championship

## **Irish Sport Horses once again showed their class at the FEI WBFSH Young Horse Championship, taking home medals in both show jumping and eventing**

As the 2022 season drew to a close, all eyes moved to the FEI WBFSH Jumping and Eventing World Breeding Championship for Young Horses, taking place in Lanaken, Belgium for show jumping, and Le Lion D'Angers, France for eventing. 2022 certainly did not disappoint with Irish Sport Horses once again proving to be some of the best horses in the world.

Taking place towards the end of September, Ireland claimed two victories at the FEI WBFSH Jumping World Breeding Championship for Young Horses at Lanaken.

A brilliant performance saw Kilkenny's Ger O'Neill and Irish Sport Horse BP Goodfellas, bred by Kevin Babington and Ballypatrick Stables, crowned World Champions in the five-year-old final.

The result completed an incredible hat-trick of World Championships wins for O'Neill, who won the six-year-old world title with the Irish Sport Horse Killossery Kaiden in 2016 and was World Champion again in 2017 with the Irish Sport Horse Columbcille Gipsy.

Having come through two intense qualifying rounds earlier in the week that attracted over 240 starters, the top 47 combinations took their place in the final to see who would be crowned World Champions.

18 horses and riders jumped clear in the first round to make it into the jump-off, with two of those for Ireland. Third-last to go against the clock, O'Neill and BP Goodfellas stormed into the lead with a stunning clear round in 40.12 seconds to take the championship. Speaking after his winning round, O'Neill said:

"It's an absolutely fantastic day, I was a winner here in 2016 with a six-year-old and again in 2017.

"It's very nice to come back and win it again. It's a great feeling at a World Championship, it's unbelievable to win it. Huge thanks to Greg and Cheryl Broderick and to Kevin Babington, everyone out here giving me a hand, it's really a team effort from Ireland here which is huge. To win on an Irish horse is also fantastic."

### Dream Debut

The win was followed by flawless rounds by Ethen Ahearne and Irish Sport Horse ABC Saving Grace, owned and bred by Patrick Kehoe, as the pair took the six-year-old crown. It was the culmination of a long season for Ahearne and his mare, who competed in the Horse Sport Ireland Studbook Series through the summer and also at the Dublin Horse Show. The delighted Tipperary man admitted it felt a bit surreal to win his first World Championship but knew from early in the week that he was in contention for honours.

A massive 270 combinations entered the competition, with the top 40 making it through to the final. 14 combinations went forward to the jump-off, with Ahearne and ABC Saving Grace – the sole Irish representatives – winning with a brilliant clear in 36.74 seconds.

"We had had a busy season – I had built her up through the Horse Sport Ireland competitions and then at Dublin, where thankfully she had qualified at the first time of asking," Ahearne said. "It was actually difficult to get her back to peak again for Lanaken, keep her fresh and well, but she has a really big heart and is a real trier when she gets into the ring. And on the day, she rose to the occasion, in fairness to her.

"She felt great in the first round, I was going day-by-day though. After jumping around the first day, I knew she was on her game and the only way she would make a mistake was that if I made it for her. I suppose that brings its own pressure, but I was quietly confident, without getting too excited. And I was looking forward to Sunday, where she was brilliant again and put in a great round in the jump-off again.

"It's surreal to think we're World Champions, to be honest. Very

nice, but surreal. I'm also delighted for Pat, her breeder too. It can be a long old road for a breeder. He had her mother jumping but it can be a long time before you can get a result like this as a breeder so I'm very happy for him.

"I must also thank all my team at home for putting in the hard yards so that I can come somewhere like here to compete, as well as Horse Sport Ireland, and all the Irish who were out here and helped me as we got towards the jump-off in the final."

Breeder Kehoe added: "This really is the stuff of dreams, it's an unbelievable achievement. It's all part of a long-term plan that started back in 2006 when I bought the dam, Ardenhue Diamond Cruiser and I'm so lucky to have a mare like her. When I got home, I had to give her a big hug and tell her she bred a world champion.

"It's so hard to describe the feeling, as a breeder this is my Olympics. I must also say how nice it was to be there and specially to see the Irish team pull together to support Ethen before he went in the jump-off. It was a fantastic example of team camaraderie. The adrenaline is still running here, I'm still buzzing. I really can't describe how proud I am of Ethen and ABC Saving Grace."

### Top Ten Placings for Irish Sport Horses at Le Lion

The FEI WBFSH Eventing World Breeding Championship for Young Horses at Le Lion d'Angers is one of the final dates on the international eventing calendar with 2022 proving to be yet another successful year for Irish Sport Horses.

In the six-year-old division three Irish Sport Horses finished inside the top six, with the highlight being an excellent runner-up finish for HSH Connor (ISH), bred by Justin Burke and ridden by Caroline Martin (USA). Speaking about HSH Connor, Martin said, "He's such a great jumper, such a great brain. He's really bred for the sport." It's no secret that Martin, a rising star on the international stage, is a big supporter of Irish horses and speaking about them to Horse Sport Ireland at Le Lion D'Angers, she said; "I would say 90% of my horses come out of Ireland. They've the best brains and they're fantastic cross country. I think sometimes people get so caught up with the dressage but at the end of the day you have to have a good cross-country horse that you can trust and that's where the Irish horses come in."

Midnight Endeavour (ISH), bred by James Nash and ridden by Tom Jackson (GBR), finished in fourth place, while Sumas Tina Turner (ISH), bred by Suma Stud and ridden by Isabel English (GBR) finished sixth. Aoife Clarke finished best of the Irish riders in 19th place with Monbeg Ainslie (ISH), bred by Nicholas Cousins. Irish Sport Horses also dominated in the seven-year-old competition, filling five of the top-10 places. Dasset Arthalent (ISH), bred by Catherine Abbott and ridden by Piggy March (GBR) finished as runners-up while SBH Big Wall (ISH), bred by John P Murphy and ridden by Izzy Taylor (GBR) finished fourth. Ian Cassells was best of the Irish riders in fifth place with Rosconnell Alto (ISH), bred by Patrick Lacey. Shanroe Cooley (ISH), bred by Anthony Smyth and ridden by Elisabeth Halliday-Sharp (USA) finished eighth, while 10th place went to HSH Blake (ISH), bred by Justin Burke and also ridden by Caroline Martin (USA).

In total, the Irish Sport Horse had 36 representatives ridden by 12 different nationalities at the Championship, with The Warmblood Studbook of Ireland also fielding one representative, making Ireland the most represented country and the ISH the most represented Studbook.
