



HSI Three and Four-Year-Old Loose-Jumping Filly Competitions

Criteria and Scoring System

These competitions are for three and four-year-old fillies and aim to identify young performance fillies that may be suitable for the breeding herd. By entering you provide consent to have your filly linear profiled for research at these events. Filly loose jumping is funded by the Department of Agriculture, Food, and the Marine under National Breeding Services.

- The filly horse competitions are open to any three or four-year-old horse that is studbook registered with a breed recorded (this can include main or supplementary section studbook animals)
 - The top ranked Traditional Irish Horse (TIH) filly will be awarded a prize in the 3- & 4-year-old horse loose jumping sections
- The filly pony competition is open to any three and four-year-old pony that is studbook registered with a breed recorded (this can include main or supplementary section studbook animals)

Passports must be available for inspection by HSI staff and judges at the competitions. Prize money will not be paid to fillies that do not meet the registration requirements.

Pony loose jumping competition, for studbook registered ponies will run at:

- Creagh Equestrian Centre on Thursday 19th October 2023
 - Closing date Tuesday 17th October 2023

Horse loose jumping competitions will run as follows:

- Kernans EC (HORSES ONLY) Thursday 2nd November 2023
Closing date - Tuesday 31st October 2023
- Tubberbride EC (HORSES ONLY) Thursday 9th November 2023
Closing date - Tuesday 7th November 2023
- Top Flight, Warrington (HORSES ONLY) Monday 13th November 2023
Closing date – Thursday 9th November 2023

Entries are to be completed online, but payment should go directly to the venues.

Please note that late entries will not be included on the start list and therefore will not receive the maximum promotion possible.

The filly pony competition is open to any three and four-year-old pony that is studbook registered with a breed recorded. The loose jumping pony competition will have a height restriction based on the measurement of the height at the withers which cannot exceed a maximum of 151.0cm with shoes on the day of competition. Pony height will be measured by a veterinarian on the day.
