Information on Import Notifications

Since March 2016 under Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2035

- Where a passport is issued to a horse outside of Ireland, Keepers are required to lodge the passport with an approved PIO here in Ireland so that its identification details are recorded on the Irish central database.
- If an identity document passport was lodged prior to March 2016 it will not appear on the central database (AIMS). An import notification is required so that its identification details are recorded on the Irish central database.

Information on Endorsements

- If the animal does not fulfil the requirements for the crossbreeding programme for the studbook for which they applied, they will be listed as unclassified (i.e. not entered into a studbook) on the IHR until they present and are passed at Inspection. The animal will not be endorsed into a studbook.
- Please indicate overleaf, the studbook into which you want to record the animal (for breeding purposes only).

Important Information:

Equine Premises Number - It is a legal requirement under the Control on Places where Horses are kept Regulations (SI 113 of 2014) that all premises where equines are kept must be registered with the Department of Agriculture. Accordingly, you should ensure that your equine is being kept on a registered premises. If your holding is not already registered as an Equine Premises, you should apply immediately to DAFM for an Equine Premises Number.

Further points to note:

1. The passport is not a deed of ownership
2. This document is a legal declaration (with penalties under the Animal Health and Welfare Act 2013.)
3. It is a legal requirement that the document of Identification (passport) should always accompany the equine.
