Arena : 80m x 40m Grass

Marathon: 2 Sections and cool down with up to 7 obstacles (6 for novice classes; 5 for pre-novice; 4 for VSE). Section A approximately 3-4km on forest and/or field tracks; Section B approximately 8km on relatively flat tracks and grass land. Obstacles open for inspection from Friday 20th June at 6pm.

Obstacle Cone Driving: Obstacle Fault Competition. Axles to be extended to appropriate width.

All competitors must be members of HSI/CDI or NICDA. All competitors must have their own personal insurance that covers competitive driving trials events and includes third party cover.

Close of entries: Tuesday 17th June at midnight.

Entry fee: €90 all classes.

Stabling: Horses can be corralled with electric tape or side stabled on site. There are limited stables and paddocks available – please contact organisers.

Parking: Parking available on grass (please follow signs)

Site opening: Site opens Friday June 20th at 3pm.

Catering:

- Saturday night: Catered meal. €20 per head, children €10, BYOB welcome. <u>Payable on the</u> evening, cash only but please indicate numbers on entry form.
- Catering van on site Saturday and Sunday

Prizes:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd Rosettes for the individual phases and overall winner in each class.
- Prizes for lowest overall pre-novice, novice and open/advanced scores.
- Various prizes within individual phases.

Health and safety: Health and Safety standards will be enforced always. All persons on the showground or course will be held responsible for complying with these standards at all times and will not put themselves or any other person at risk in any way whatsoever. Any accidents shall be reported to the Safety Officer or the Events Secretary at the time of the occurrence.

Quads/scooters: May be used to access the obstacles at competitors' risk. Suitable and properly secured hard hats should be worn by anyone on a motorised bike or quad.

Request to drive obstacles with a motorised vehicle must submitted with your entry, an event approval pass will be issued on your arrival and must be visible on motorised vehicle

If using Google Maps, please enter Cooley Farm as the destination which will take you directly to the entrance gates of the event. Do not use an Eircode as this will bring you to the wrong location. <u>From Dublin / Belfast:</u> Take Exit 16 off the N11. Take the first exit off the roundabout. Enter Rathnew. Take the 2nd exit at the mini roundabout in the town and continue on that road to Glenealy. The Cooley Farm entrance is on your right just after Glenealy village.

From South: Take Exit 16 off the N11. Take the 3rd exit off the first roundabout and the Rathnew exit at the second. Enter Rathnew. Take the 2nd exit at the mini roundabout in the town and continue on that road to Glenealy. The Cooley Farm entrance is on your right just after Glenealy village.
